	05.11.2022	A regular bail petition dated 13.10.2022 registered as MCA No. 1289/2022 filed on behalf of accused/petitioner namely Ajit Kumar Pandey @ Ajit Pandey, aged about 25 years, UID No. 554086268883, S/o Devan Pandey, resident of village Dewariya, PS Sadar, District Chatra in connection with Chatra, Sadar PS Case No. 262/2022, dated 05.08.2022 registered for the offence U/s 21, 22, 25, 27 of the NDPS Act pending in this court for cognizance. The learned advocate appeared on behalf of the accused/petitioner submitted that the accused/petitioner is innocent, has not committed any offence and falsely been implicated in this case on mere suspicion. It has been further submitted that the allegation contained in the FIR is totally false, fabricated and concocted one. It has been further submitted that nothing has been seized or recovered from his conscious possession and he is in Judicial custody since 06.08.2022,thus, prayed to enlarge him on

On the other hand learned P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that from possession of the accused/petitioner 0.45 grams and 0.35 grams brown sugar kept in two Puriya was recovered. On completion of Investigation Charge Sheet has been submitted against him, thus, he does not deserve bail. Heard both sides and perused the case record. The accused/petitioner is named in the FIR of Chatra, Sadar PS Case No. 262/2022, dated 05.08.2022 registered for the offence U/s 21, 22, 25, 27 of the NDPS Act alleging therein that on 05.08.2022 at 08.05 AM he received a secret information that at Baba Ghat two boys were involved in sell and purchase of brown sugar. On that information the informant informed his superior officer and on their directions a raiding team was constituted under the leadership of SDPO, Chatra and at 09.10 AM they reached at Baba Ghat near pond, then on seeing the police party two persons tried to flee away but they were apprehended by the police party and on interrogation	

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	Contd P/3 05.11.2022	disclosed their name as Abhijeet Kumar @ Mintu Kumar and Ajit Pandey (petitioner) and from possession of accused/petitioner and from the possession of Ajit Pandey 0.45 gram and 0.35 gram brown sugar with paper was recovered which was seized in presence of witnesses by preparing seizure list and case was registered. From perusal of the case record it appears that from possession of the accused/petitioner 0.45 grams and 0.35 grams brown sugar kept in two paper Puriya was recovered which is less than commercial quantity and accused/petitioner is in custody since 06.08.2022. Therefore, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the accused/petitioner Ajit Kumar Pandey @ Ajit Pandey is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each.
