The applicant has filed the present application under Section 430 (1) of BNSS for suspending the operation of impugned judgment/order dated 16.5.2026 passed by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sirmaur District at Nahan, in criminal case No. 68/2 of 2019, whereby the applicant has been convicted and sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of two years and to pay a fine of ₹3000/- for the commission of offence punishable under Section 409 of IPC; simple imprisonment for two years and to pay a fine of ₹2000/- for the commission of offence punishable under Section 467 of IPC; simple imprisonment for one year and to pay a fine of ₹1000/- for the commission of offence punishable under Section 468 of IPC; simple imprisonment for a period of six months and to pay a fine of ₹1000/- for the commission of offence punishable under Section 471 of IPC. Since the main appeal has been admitted for hearing and the same is likely to take some time for disposal, hence, the execution of judgment of sentence passed against the applicant is suspended till the final disposal of the main appeal subject to depositing of fine amount, if not already deposited and furnishing of personal bond in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount before the learned trial Court within a period of 30 days, undertaking therein that in the event of failure of this appeal, the applicant shall surrender before the learned trial Court to receive the sentence. The application stands disposed off. It be tagged with the main appeal file. Copy of this order be sent to the learned trial Court.
