

Plaintiff No.1,2 and defendant No.2 and their respective counsels are present. Sri. S.S.C has filed I.A.No.I U/O 6 Rule 17 of CPC for amend the plaint. Copy served on other side. Sri. G.V.J for defendant No.2 has been submitting that no objection to IA.No.1 and may be allowed. In view submission of the counsel for defendant No.2 and grounds for amendment in respect extent of the suit property as wrongly mentioned in the plaint schedule, it requires to amend the plaint, hence IA.No.1 is allowed. For amendment and amended plaint. Sri. S.S.C is submitting that it may be permitted to amend the plaint before the open Court. Hence in request of plaintiff counsel this Court is permitted to amend the plaint in open Court. Amendment carried out and amended plaint is furnished. The plaintiffs and defendant No.2 are submitting that they are ready to compromise the case. Plaintiff No.1,2 and defendant No.2 have jointly filed compromise petition Under Order 23 Rule 3 R/w. Section 151 of CPC along with passport size photos of the both parties. The plaintiff No.1,2 and defendant No.2 have produced Aadhaar cards of the all defendant No.2 and plaintiff No.1 and 2. The contents of compromise petition are read over and explained to the parties. They submit that they have signed compromise petition having understood its contents, terms and conditions without any coercion, threat or undue influence, misrepresentation etc. Perused the case records. From enquiry it appears that the plaintiff No.1,2 and defendant No.2 are ready to take 1/2 share i.e., 1 acre 13 gunthas in the suit property and they have agreed to compromise the case as per their settlement In respect of suit schedule property the plaintiff No.1,2 and

*defendant No.2 have produced recent RTC extract. The parties have voluntarily entered into the compromise and the compromise is in accordance with law. There is no impediment to reject the compromise petition submitted by the both parties. Accordingly, the compromise petition is accepted. The suit of the plaintiff is decreed in terms of compromise petition. The compromise petition shall part and parcel of the decree.*
