1. From 2014 to 2023 I working as as Scientific Officer,
FSL, Bengaluru.

2. On 10.03.2022, our office received 2 sealed articles in
respect of the case in Cr.No.041/2022 of Virajpet Rural Police
Station through PC.No.156-Sannaswamy B. The seals on the

articles were intact and tallied with the sample seal. The reception department of our office received them and gave them our office number RFSL/BS/272/2022. The said materials were sent to my department for examination.

3. When I opened the articles for examination I found following articles which also contains the IO marking as below.

4. I have subjected these articles for Chemical examination and serological examination.

1. The blood stain was detected in article Nos.1 and 2.
2. Articles Nos.1 and 2 were stained with human blood.

3.Articles Nos.1 and 2 were stained with “A” group blood.

5. Accordingly, I have issued certificate of examination dated 12.04.2022. After examination the articles were repacked and sealed with our office seal and sent to concerned IO. The sample seal was also enclosed along with my report. Now I see the report and sample seal through video conference, I identified my signatures. The report is marked as **Ex.P.41** my signature is marked as **Ex.P.41(a)**. The sample seal is **Ex.P.42**, my signature is marked as **Ex.P.42(a)**.

6. The articles now shown to me through VC are examined by me, which are already marked as M.O.No.1 and 2. Having examined the articles I have affixed sticker on each article with seal and signature, same are marked as **M.O.No.1(a) and 2(a)** respectively.

7. In continuation on 14.03.2022, our office received 6 sealed articles in respect of the case in Cr.No.0041/2022 of Virajpet Rural Police Station through PC.No.128-Siman D Cunha. The seals on the articles were intact and tallied with the sample seal. The reception department of our office received them and gave them our office number RFSL/BS/289/2022. The said materials were sent to my department for examination.

9. I have subjected these articles for Chemical examination and serological examination.

1. The blood stains was detected in article Nos.1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6.

2. Article Nos.1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 were stained with human blood.

3. Article Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 was stained with 'A' group blood.

The cuttings and scrapings have been completely used for serological analysis. I have mentioned my certificate of examination regarding method of analysis and result of analysis.

10. I have issued certificate of examination. Now I identified the certificate of examination through VC, same is

marked as Ex.P.43 and Ex.P.43(a) is my signature. The sample seal is marked as Ex.P.44, Ex.P.44(a) is my signature.

11. After examination all the articles were repacked and I have put our office seal on these articles and also prepared sample seal and sent to the sealed articles with the sample seal to the concerned police.

12. The M.O.3 to 8 now shown to me through VC are examined by me. Having examined those articles I have affixed with the seal and signature. The seal the signature are marked as M.O.No.3(a) to 8(a) respectively.

13. First two articles were received on 10.03.2022, the subsequently six articles were received on 14.03.2022. In respect of same crime number, the articles are received by our

office for more than one, the all the articles will be sent to same section and also to the same officer by the Assistant Director of Biology section. It is incorrect to suggest that the report is prepared as per the convenience of the Investigation Officer in random manner.
