1. I have two children, they are Chane and Chikki. It is false to suggest that my husband Late Kariya had another wife. My daughter Chikki is residing at Irpu. My daughter is not party to the petition. I was present at the accident spot. On the date of accident it was Monday holiday. Myself and my late husband did not had alcohol. It is false to suggest that my husband after consuming alcohol he was standing on road and accident was took place.
2. Respondent No.1 had caused accident. It is false to suggest that respondent No.1 was not present at the time of incident. It is false to suggest that respondent No.1 did not drove the vehicle in rash and negligent manner and caused accident. I am aged about 45 years. My husband on the date of death he was aged about 58 years, I denied that he

3. was aged about 70 years. I deny that respondent No.1 helped my family and he has helped my husband for treatment. My husband was not well. I am residing with my son petitioner No.2. I am not working in estate, but my son is working in estate. I deny that on the date of death of my husband, he was residing alone, myself and my son were residing together. I deny that my husband was aged about 70 years, he was retired and he was not working. I deny that I have filed false petition against respondent No.1 to claim compensation, without impleading other legal heirs.
