This petition is referred to the Lok Adalat at the request of both counsel by the Motor Accident Claim Tribunal/VI Additional District Judge's Court, Kadapa.

This petition is coming on this day for final settlement in the presence of the petitioner and respondents, and **Sri Rajesh Kumar Reddy**, advocate for petitioner and **Sri A.Sampath Kumar, Advocate for R.3 and Respondent Nos.1 and 2 called absent remained set exparte**, Both parties to the petition have agreed for amicable settlement with free will and violation. Hence, the following award is passed as per the settlement arrived by the parties.

AWARD U/SEC.21 OF LEGAL SERVICES AUTHORITIES ACT, 1987

1. the matter settled for claim for an amount of Rs.1,45,000/-(Rupees One Lakh Fourty Five Thousand Only) towards full and final settlement.
2. The 3rd respondent insurance company agreed to pay the amount of Rs 1,45,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fourty Five Thousand Only) to the petitioner. The petitioner Guardian is also agreed to settle the case for said amount. Out of the said amount the petitioner guardian is entitle an amount of Rs 45,000/- (Rupees Fourty Five Thousand Only) and Remaining balance amount of Rs 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) shall kept in any Nationalized bank till the petitioner attain majority. When the petitioner attain their majority he is at liberity to receive the amount of Rs 1,00,000/- with accrued interest thereon from the Hon'ble court.
3. That the 3rd respondent shall pay the awarded amount in the court within One month from the date of the award. The Gurdain of the petitioner permitted to withdraw the amount of Rs 45,000/-. (Rupees Fourty Five Thousand Only) after deposited award amount by the 3rd respondent in the court.
4. The court fee paid by the petitioners if any shall be refund to them.
5. Accordingly, Award is passed.

The contents of the award are read over and explained to both parties in vernacular language and admitted by them to be true and correct.

Both parties affixed their signatures in evidence of their consent for the terms of award.
