The above named petitioners, who are in custody since 30-11-2022 seek regular bail in connection with the present Rupaspur P.S. Case No.783/2022, registered U/Ss.341, 323, 307 and 504/34 I.P.C. which is pending in the Court of A.C.J.M. 1st Class, Danapur

Allegation against the petitioners, in brief, is that they hit on the head of informant and inflicted him head injury. Allegation against other co-accused persons is that they assaulted informant's sister who had come to rescue informant

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that petitioners have no criminal antecedent. They are innocent and have been falsely implicated. Sec.307 of I.P.C. is not attracted against the petitioners. Moreover, they are in custody since 30-11-2022. Hence, they may be allowed bail.

Perused the C.C. of F.I.R. and copy of case-diary.

Injury report forwarded with the case-diary discloses that informant and his sister have received lacerated wound injury on their head, which have been found to be simple in nature by the doctor.

Considering the nature of allegation and their period of custody, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners on their furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each.
