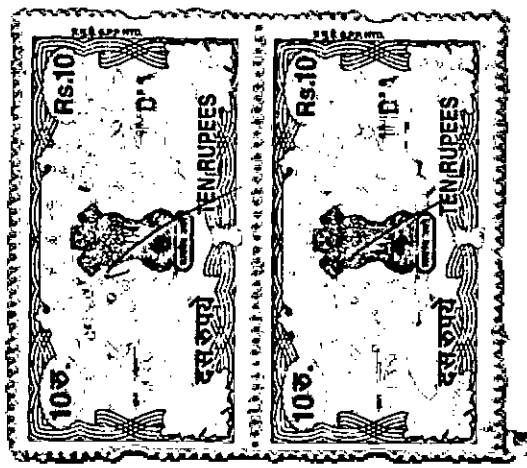

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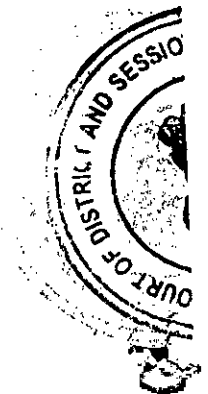
**APPLICATION FOR STAY AND SUSPENSION OF

- (b) Any other order which this Hon'ble Court thinks fit to grant.

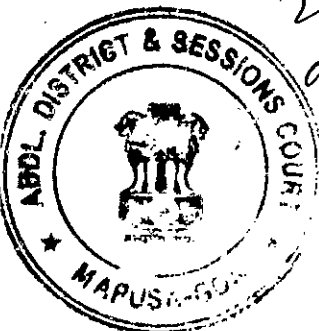
