09.01.2023	This regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely Dilip Sadai is in connection with Jhanjharpur police station case 137 of 2022. It has been submitted on behalf of petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case by the police. Further it has been submitted on behalf of petitioner that earlier an ABP No. 674/2022 filed on behalf of this petitioner was rejected vide order dated 15.11.2022 and no any other regular or anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of petitioner either before sessions court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. It is submitted that petitioner is in judicial custody since 03/12/2022. Therefore petitioner may be enlarged on bail. Ld, APP opposed the prayer for bail. It appears from the record that case has been registered under section 341/323/307/354(A)/353/504/506/34 IPC against this petitioner and others on the basis of written report submitted by Renu Devi ASI of police. It has been alleged by the informant that on the alleged date of occurrence at about 1 PM she along with other police personals had gone to made enquiry regarding land dispute and during that this petitioner assembled there with various arms and attacked the police party. Accused Shri Sadai tried to assault ASI Sanjay Kumar Singh by means of knife over his neck. Informant has also alleged that accused persons also assaulted her and other police personals and also threatened to implicate them in false case. It appears that informant and others witnesses have supported the allegations but it appears from the injury reports that all the injuries are simple in nature and caused by hard blunt substance and further considering the fact that this petitioner is in custody since 03.12.2022, so aforesaid petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000 with two surities of like amount to the satisfaction of learned court below. 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agitated and they may commit any occurrence with his family and due to that he has assembled with other criminals in order to teach lesson to family member of the deceased Rajnarayan Mandal. It appears from the case dairy that informant and other witlessness have supported the allegations in their statement and all the accused persons have been arrested by the informant who is police officer with illegal fire arms and ammunition and stolen four wheeler vehicle with co accused Bindeshwar Mandal who has confessed that he had murdered his neighbor Rajnarayan Mandal and again he had assembled with these petitioners in order to commit some occurrence with the family member of the aforesaid deceased Rajnarayan Mandal and since investigation in this case is still going on . Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances I am not inclined to grant bail to these petitioners accordingly this regular bail petition is hereby **rejected**.
