29-05-2023	This criminal revision has been directed against the impugned proceeding as contained in the notice dated 30-11-2022 issued by the learned SDM, Phulparas in M.R.case No. 1071/2022, by which, the learned SDM, Phulparas has started a proceeding u/s 107 of the CrPC against the revisionists asking them to file their show cause as to why they should not execute bond of Rs.2,00,000/-with two sureties of the like amount each for maintaining peace for the period of one year. No one turned up on behalf of the petitioners on repeated call to press the revision petition. From perusal of the record, it transpires that the instant revision petition is pending on the stage of admission and petitioners remained absent on several dates. This shows that petitioners are not serious and interested to press this criminal revision. Further, the impugned order is interlocutory order by which person concerned has been directed to show cause why he should not be bound in the prescribed manner. Neither rights of parties are decided nor matter in dispute is finally disposed off. Section 397 (2) Cr.P.C. bars exercise of revisional jurisdiction of the court with regard to such order.
