Offence : Punishable under sections 143, 269, 271 r/w 149 of the I.P.C. & 4 (2) (e) of the Kerala Epidemic Diseases Ordinance.

This case having been finally heard on this day, the Court delivered the following:-

J U D G M E N T

The accused no.1 in this case stands charge-sheeted by the Sub Inspector of Police, Nedumkandam Police Station in Cr. no.737/20.

2. Copy is served. The accused no.1 pleaded guilty through the counsel. The plea being voluntary is accepted. Hence, the accused no.1 is found guilty and convicted and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 700/- for the offences under sections 143, 269, 271 r/w 149 of the I.P.C. & 4 (2) (e) of the Kerala Epidemic Diseases Ordinance and in default of payment of fine he has to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of 10 days. Case against A2 to A5 refiled as CC 244/2023.
