Cross examination by Sri.JS learned counsel for respondent No.2: -

The accident had occurred on 20/5/2022 around 4.30am. Myself, my wife and my daughter were traveling in an autorickshaw. We were traveling in an auto from Kolar to Srinivasapura. We did not instruct the driver of auto to move the vehicle in high speed. It is false to suggest that we have given instructions to the driver of auto to move the vehicle in high speed therefore the accident had occurred. My father took us to SNR hospital. From there we were taken to Jalappa hospital for higher treatment.

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I had suffered injuries to my shoulder and legs. It is true to suggest that I had suffered only 3 injuries, 2 simple and one grievous injury. I had taken treatment as in patient for 4 months. It is false to suggest that I had taken treatment as in patient for one week as per the medical record. I do not remember from what date to what date I had taken treatment. I had taken treatment as per the doctors instructions. I had not undergone surgery. I had taken followup treatment as per medical advise. I had taken Physiyo therapy. I am not suffering from any pain after the treatment. I had taken free treatment in government hospital.

I have not produced any medical bills regarding my treatment and for spending Rs. 4 lakhs towards my treatment. I am getting difficulty in stretching my hands. I have taken alternate medicines(Herbal) for my injuries. In regard to Herbal medicine treatment I have not produced any documents.

It is false to suggest that I am not earning Rs. 1 lakh out of my occupation. I am not paying income tax. There is 2 days delay in filing the complaint. I do not know whether the driver of auto had no license therefore company had not

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liable to pay the compensation amount. I do not know that the autorickshaw had no fitness certificate and permit.
