

Rana Singh versus State

The present bail application put up before me being Duty Officer. In the present case FIR No. 22 dated 18.02.2020 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, P. S. Dirba, the applicant-accused namely Rana Singh son of Mahinder Singh, resident of Surjan Basti, Dirba, District Sangrur was already admitted to interim bail for six weeks vide order dated 27.03.2020 passed by the Court of Sh. Sham Lal, Ld. Judge, Special Court, Sangrur in view of the directions and guidelines contained in the minutes of meeting held under the Chairmanship of Honorable Mr. Justice R. K. Jain, Judge, Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh on 25.03.2020, followed by directions and guidelines received from Member Secretary, PSLSA, SAS Nagar, vide letter bearing no. 1390 dated 27.03.2020.

Further in view of the directions and guidelines of the minutes of meeting of review meeting of High Powered Committee held under the Chairmanship of Honorable Mr. Justice R. K. Jain, Judge, Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh and Executive Chairman Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh on 02.05.2020 conveyed vide memo No.12/16/2020-2H7/796-800 dated 02.05.2020, the interim bail of six weeks already granted to the above-named applicant-accused is further extended for another six weeks subject to his furnishing fresh personal bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- to the satisfaction of Superintendent, District Jail, Sangrur and the following conditions:-

- i. That the applicant will make himself available in the investigation of the case, as and when required;

- ii. That the applicant will not tamper with the prosecution evidence;
- iii. That the applicant will not leave the country without prior permission of the court.

3. It is made clear that **this relief of interim bail will subsist only for a period of six weeks** whereafter the **applicant/accused shall surrender in the Jail itself on 19.06.2020** in accordance with law.

4. The Superintendent, District Jail, Sangrur is directed to take the personal bond containing above conditions from the applicant-accused to his satisfaction and thereafter release him. **Separate release warrant will not be issued by the Court.** He is further directed to send the personal bond to the Court concerned positively within one month.

With the above observations, the bail application stands disposed of without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case. Bail papers be attached with the remand papers.
