Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted after obtaining instructions from the complainant, that the complainant is also ready to participate in the mediation proceedings for exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement of the aforesaid dispute.

On the aforesaid joint request of both the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned counsel for the complainant, both the parties are directed to come present in person for their participation in the aforesaid mediation proceedings on dated **06.02.2026**.

The arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed till the date fixed to facilitate her participation in the aforesaid mediation proceedings for exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement of the aforesaid dispute. It is hereby made clear that the aforesaid stay on arrest of the petitioner is granted just to facilitate her participation in the aforesaid mediation proceedings and it shall not be construed as grant of stay on arrest of the petitioner on merits and if the aforesaid mediation proceedings will fail, then the present bail petition shall be decided on merits thereafter after hearing both the parties.
