**Further chief examination by Sri.LS learned counsel for
Petitioner:-**

I have produced the following documents i.e.,

- 1) I have produced the Original Medical Bills (91 in number) totaling to Rs.1,58,895/- which are collectively marked as ExP13.

2) I have produced the Medical Prescription (74 in number) which are collectively marked as ExP14.

3) I have produced the 2 discharge summaries issued by KIMS hospital and which are marked as Ex.P15 and Ex.P16.

Cross-examination by Sri. BK learned counsel for the respondent: -

Bus was belonging to green valley 1st respondent school. For the past 20 years I am doing the work of cleaner in the green valley school bus. I was getting Rs.7,500/- monthly salary. I am also doing the work of boarding and alighting the children of bus. One Nandish kumar was driver of the bus. Our bus driver was driving the bus in high speed when two wheeler came from opposite direction he could not control bus it turtled. I was standing on the foot board of the bus at the time of accident.

Police have enquired me in the hospital. I have given statement before the police about the accident. 30 children were traveling in the bus. Children have not suffered any injuries. I went to SNR hospital for first aid and thereafter I went to KIMS hospital, Bengaluru for further treatment. The school authorities have not given money for my medical treatment. I had taken treatment in the hospital for 2 months. I had taken follow-up treatment as out patient for 5 times in KIMS hospital.

I do not know whether I had given follow-up treatment documents to court as I am an illiterate person. Dr. Sudheer had treated me. I am not working. Doctor had not written that I should not work. It is false to suggest that I had spent Rs. 4 lakh towards medical treatment. It is false to suggest that by creating documents I am deposing falsely.
