

Chief examination by Sri. TRJ learned counsel for Petitioner:-

I am the petitioner in this petition and I have filed my affidavit in lieu of my examination in chief, which contains my signatures.

I have produced the following documents i.e.,

- 1). I have produced the certified copy of the FIR and it is marked as ExP1.
- 2). I have produced the certified copy of complaint which is marked as ExP2.
- 3) I have produced the certified copy of the 2nd FIR and it is marked as ExP3.
- 4). I have produced the certified copy of 2nd complaint and it is marked as ExP4.
- 5) I have produced the certified copy of the spot mahazar which is marked as ExP5.
- 6) I have produced the certified copy of the spot sketch which is marked as ExP6.
- 7) I have produced the certified copy of the IMV report which is marked as ExP7.
- 8) I have produced the certified copy of the inquest report which is marked as ExP8.

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9) I have produced the certified copy of the PM report which is marked as ExP9.

10) I have produced the certified copy of the charge sheet which is marked as ExP10.

11) I have produced the Original Medical Bills (6 in number) totaling to Rs.15,658/- which are collectively marked as ExP11.

12). I have produced the Medical Prescriptions (6 in number) which are collectively marked as ExP12.

Cross examination by Sri.BK learned counsel for respondent:-

Petitioner No.2 and 4 are residing in their husband's house. Petitioner No.3 is residing separately. I was residing with my father. I had not seen the accident. I have given complaint before the police. I do not know the vehicle number as I am illiterate. I do not know the name of the two wheeler. Police have not enquired me. I am doing stone work and earning Rs. 600/- per day. My brother Nagaraj was also doing coolie and earning Rs.600/- per day. Till I reach the place of accident my father who met with an accident was there. My father got admitted to hospital and was taking treatment for 3 days and thereafter he died. My father also doing coolie work. He was also earning Rs.600/- per day. It is false to suggest that my father cross the road suddenly

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and therefore he met with an accident and died. It is false to suggest that my father was aged 85 years and he was doing any work. It is false to suggest that my father was getting Rs.30,000/- per month as coolie. It is false to suggest that by colluding with police false case is filed against the respondents claiming compensation.
