The Ld. Counsel for the petitioners have given undertakings that no other bail application of the petitioners are pending before the Hon'ble High Court or any other Court having concurrent jurisdiction to entertain the bail application.

The petitioners being aggrieved by the order dated 31.07.2026 passed by the learned SDJM, Bhubaneswar in CT Case No.1827/2026 U/S 126(2)/115(2)/117(2)/109(1)/296/324(4)/304(2)/3(5) of BNS have filed these applications U/S.483 BNSS to release them on bail.

Heard the learned counsels for both the sides.

The prosecution allegation is that on 29.03.2026 around 4:30 to 5 PM while the informant Biplaba Nisanka was returning from the coaching centre in his motor cycle, three unknown persons caused disturbances and assaulted him. It is alleged that the culprits have taken away Rs.7,600/- from him. While the informant raised hullah, they assaulted him by means of a stone on his head.

After registration of the FIR, the petitioners were arrested and forwarded to the Court on 30.07.2026. Their bail applications were rejected which is the subject matter of the present bail applications.

On perusal of the record, it is learnt that no money has been seized from the possession of the petitioners. The injury report reveals that the informant sustained pain on his head. He has not sustained any external injury. The petitioners have no criminal back ground. They are the men of the locality and inside the custody for a considerable period.

Taking into consideration the above facts and circumstances, I am inclined to release the petitioners on bail. Accordingly, the bail applications of the petitioners are allowed.

Let the petitioners be released on bail by furnishing bail bonds of Rs.50,000/- with one solvent surety each for the like amount subject to the condition that;

- (i) They shall not involve in any criminal activities while on bail.

Violation of any condition entails cancellation of bail.
