ORDER

This order of mine shall dispose of second regular bail applications preferred by applicants in FIR no. 126 dated 07.11.2024 under Sections 318(4), 274,275,276,277,336(2)(3) BNS, PS IT City, Mohali. The first bail application was dismissed vide order dated (Baljinder Singh Sra), ASJ, SAS Nagar

2. Notice of the application was issued to the State and record was also requisitioned. In response thereto learned Addl. PP for the State has put in appearance.

3. Perusal of the record indicates that the FIR has been registered on the basis of a secret information received by ASI Ramesh Lal on 07.11.2024 to the effect that Chhinda Singh son of Sital Singh , Harpreet Singh son of Tarsem Singh , Sumit Kumar son of Ram Dyal have been preparing fake and spurious allopathic drugs/medicines in plot no. 597, M.K. Technology Park. Finding the information to be credible, a police party headed by him raided the disclosed place. On conducting raid, it was found that they have installed machines, collected huge quantity of salts for preparing fake and spurious allopathic medicines by branding it with the packing material of renowned pharmaceutical companies. Be it recorded herein that Drug Inspector Gurpreet Singh was also associated in the raid and he participated in the entire operation. DSP Harsimran Singh Bal and Inspector Simarjit Singh SHO, IT City also arrived at the time of conducting raid. Chhinda Singh, Harpreet Singh and Sumit Kumar were apprehended at the spot . The following articles were found at the spot:

Machines were fixed in the premises. Besides the aforesaid machines , spurious drugs were taken into possession. Those were dispatched to the Laboratory for chemical test. On analysis, those were found to be spurious in nature. The drugs being manufactured by the accused are commonly consumed. Accused were using the labels of the following licensed manufacturers:

1. Alkem Health Science Unit 2, Samardung, Karek Block PO Namthang , District Namchi , Sikkim.
2. Glenmark Pharmaceuticals Limited, village Kishanpura , Baddi, Nalagarh Road, Tehsil Baddi, Distt. Solan.
3. Aristo Pharmaceuticals Pvt. Ltd, Plot no. 2040-46, NH 10, Bachey Khola, PO Majhitar, East Sikkim.

4 It thus, transpires from the record that accused (Baljinder Singh Sra), ASJ, SAS Nagar

were actively running a unit in their premises manufacturing fake and spurious allopathic drugs of common use by using the labels and packing material of renowned pharmaceutical companies. Those drugs were being disposed off in the market which would obviously be purchased by common people by paying price and thus, they were being cheated on a huge scale by the accused. Besides that the fake and spurious drugs would play havoc with the health of people purchasing fake and spurious allopathic drugs being manufactured by the accused. They have prima-facie committed forgery by preparing and using forged labels and packing materials of renowned pharmaceutical companies. No changed circumstance have been pointed out by learned counsel for bail applicant to file the second bail application. Material witnesses are yet to be examined. Charge has not been framed.

5 In view of the nature of the allegations , at this stage, the applicant does not deserve the concession of regular bail. Accordingly bail application stands dismissed.

6 Police record be remitted. File be consigned to Record Room.
