This petition is coming on this day for before me in the presence of Sri D.Reddaiah, Advocate for the Petitioners/A.2 and A.3 and of Additional Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/Complainant, after perusing the material on record, and having stood over for consideration, this Court delivered the following :-

ORDER

This is an application filed by the petitioners / A.2 and A.3 under Sec.439 (1) (b) of Criminal Procedure Code, seeking the Court to relax the conditions imposed in Crl.M.P.No.744/2022 dt.24.11.2022 in Cr.No.218/2021 of C.K.Dinne Police Station.

2. The present petition filed by the petitioners/A.2 and A.3 and the averments of the petition and contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that with great respect to the orders passed by this Hon'ble Court, the petitioners have been scrupulously observing the condition imposed by

this Court, that the petitioners are regularly attending the police station and followed the condition and they are facing hardship in following the condition regularly, as the police are waiting the petitioners till the evening and that they are unable to attend their regular duties and the police also insisted them whereabouts of the other accused though they are not concern, that the investigation was completed, except filing of charge sheet and hence, requested the Court to relax the conditions imposed in Crl.M.P.No.744/2022 dt.24.11.2022 against the petitioners/A.2 and A.3.

3. Notice given to the Learned Additional Public Prosecutor and the Addl. Public Prosecutor reported no objection.

4. Heard both sides and perused the record.

5. Now the point for determination is that :- “Whether the Petitioners/ A.2 and A.3 are entitled for relaxation of conditions imposed in Crl.M.P.No.744/2022 dt.24.11.2022 by this Court” ?

6. On keen perusal of entire record, this Court has granted bail to the petitioners/A.2 and A.3 on 24.11.2022 with a condition that the petitioners shall appear before the Station House Officer, C.K.Dinne P.S., on every Saturday in between 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon till filing of charge sheet or until further orders. The petitioners/A.2 and A.3 have been complying the orders of this Court scrupulously as stated by both counsel. Considering the facts and circumstances of this petition, this court inclined to allow this petition by relaxing the condition imposed against the petitioners/A.2 and A.3 in Crl.M.P. No.744/2022 dt.24.11.2022.

8. In the result, this petition is allowed, by relaxing the condition imposed by this Court against the petitioners/A.2 and A.3 in Crl.M.P. No.744/2022 dt.24.11.2022.
