Gopamma in favour of Chinamma and sale deed dated 15.01.1981 executed by Chinamma in favour of deceased Bychappa in respect of 14 guntas land in Sy. No.54/2 i.e., suit item No.1 property is not binding on the plaintiffs ?
3. Whether the plaintiffs prove the alleged interference by the defendants ?
4. Whether the defendant No.1 proves that the suit is barred by law of limitation ?

5. Whether the defendant No.1 proves that the he is the owner and possessor of written statement schedule property ?
6. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to declaration and injunction as prayed for ?
7. What order or decree ?
