IN THE COURT OF THE II Addl. SENIOR CIVIL JUDGE
AND MACT, MANDYA
MVC 190/2017

Petitioner: Siddappa S/o Boraiah, aged about 40 years, R/o Ummadahalli village, Kasaba hobli, Mandya Taluk, Mandya District.

Versus

Respondents: 1. Ashoka H.R., Major, No.195, R/o B. Hosuru Village, Mandya Taluk and Mandya District.

(Owner of Bajaj Motor Cycle bearing Reg. No.KA-11-EF-0076)

2. The Divisional Manager, New India Assurance Co., Ltd., J.L.B. Road, Chamundipuram, Mysuru.

Petition filed by the petitioner on 06-02-2017 U/sec.166 of MV Act praying to pass Judgment and award for grant of compensation of Rs. 5,45,000-00 with interest @ 18% per annum in view of the injuries sustained by petitioner in the accident that took place on 01-10-2016 at around 7.30 p.m. due to rash negligent riding of Bajaj Motor Cycle bearing Reg. No KA-11-EF-0076 ridden by its driver.

This petition coming on this day for final disposal before **Sri. Varadaraj B. B.Sc. L.L.B, M.L. II Addl. Senior Civil Judge and MACT**, Mandya and in the presence of **Sri. H.R. Suresh** advocate for the petitioner, **Sri. M.L. Lingegowda** advocate for respondent No.1 and **Sri. B.C. Basavaraju** advocate for respondent No.2.

The petition is allowed in terms of joint memo filed by both the parties as hereunder:

It is ordered and awarded that the joint memo filed by the petitioner and the 2nd respondent is accepted. The petition filed U/Sec. 166 M. V. Act by the petitioner is allowed in terms of the compromise petition.

Further it is ordered and awarded the petitioner is awarded with compensation of **Rs. 62,000/-**.

It is further ordered and awarded that the 2nd respondent shall deposit the said compensation amount within three months, failing which they shall pay interest at the rate of 6% from the date of petition till payment.

Further it is ordered and awarded that the after deposit of the amount by the 2nd respondent the entire amount is ordered to released in favour of the petitioner after proper identification.

It is further ordered and awarded that in view of the settlement reached there is no order as to cost.
