1. Ahlmad has made an endorsement that the file has also been received on e-Portal.
2. By impugned judgment dated 16.03.2026, the appellant was acquitted of the offence punishable u/ss. 279/337/338/304A/427 IPC & sec. 187 r/w. 134(a) of M.V. Act and convicted for the offences punishable u/ss. 468/471 IPC. By order on sentence dated 09.07.2026, the appellant was sentenced to undergo 06 months simple imprisonment and fine of Rs.2,000/- for the offence punishable u/sec. 468 IPC and 02 months simple imprisonment for the offence punishable u/sec. 471 IPC.
3. The appellant has also filed an application u/sec. 430 (1) BNSS for suspension of sentence till the pendency of the appeal.
4. Heard. Perused.

5. Since this appeal shall take considerable time in its final disposal, hence the impugned judgment and order on sentence shall remain suspended till pendency of this appeal.

6. The appellant is admitted to bail for the period of pendency of present appeal, on furnishing of personal bond in the sum of Rs.10,000/-, with one surety in like amount, to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court within three days from today.

7. Notice of the appeal be issued to the respondent on filing PF/RC. Steps be taken within seven days from today.

8. Trial Court Record be called two days before the next date of hearing.

9. Be listed for arguments on appeal **17.11.2026**.
