4. Whether the defendant No.2 proves that the defendant No.2 being 'A' scheduledar has acquired the suit schedule item No.1 property bearing Sy.No.72/1 measuring 0-21 guntas by way of registered partition deed dated 31-07-2008?
5. Whether the defendant No.2 proves that Sri. Kalappa the father of defendant Nos.3 to 5 being 'B' scheduledar has acquired the suit schedule item No.1 property bearing Sy.No.71 measuring 1 acre 29 guntas by way of registered partition deed dated 31-07-2008?
6. Whether the defendant No.2 proves that the defendant No.2 is the absolute owner of suit schedule item No.3 property bearing Sy.No.46/2 as contended in para 20 of his written statement? 1
7. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the reliefs as sought for?
8. What order or decree?
