

Harpreet Singh Vs. State of Punjab BA CIS No.1023-2021

Heard. Perusal of the file shows that vide detailed order dated 4.6.2021 passed by this Court, the accused/applicant was admitted to interim bail and directed to join investigation within four days regarding recovery of remaining dowry articles and today SI Harjit Singh appeared and suffered a statement that the accused/applicant has joined investigation on 8.6.2021. Recovery of dowry articles have been effected from the accused/applicant and as per their investigation, the remaining dowry articles are with the complainant and as such he is not required for custodial interrogation.

Consequently, as per the statement of Investigating Officer, the accused/applicant has joined investigation and the dowry articles have also been recovered from the accused/applicant and when there are no allegations that after being admitted to interim bail, the accused/applicant is not co-operating, hence in these circumstances, interim bail order dated 4.6.2021 passed by this Court is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- i. that he shall not hinder the ongoing investigation or trial;
- ii. that he shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court;

iii. that he shall not make any threat, promise or inducement to any person conversant with the facts of the case to dissuade him/her from disclosing the truth to the court or police.

iv. that he shall not misuse the concession of bail failing which, this order shall stand vacated automatically.

The present bail application stands allowed accordingly. File be consigned to the record room.
