ORDER :

1. This order of mine shall dispose of the bail application
filed by applicants-accused Jarnail Singh, Jagmeetsingh Singh and Balvir
Kaur under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in a complaint case titled as
' Gurnam Singh Vs Jarnail Singh and others' bearing Regn. No.
COMI-14/2020 filed by the respondent-complainant Gurnam Singh,

in which, the applicants-accused have been ordered to be summoned by the Learned JMIC, Zira, under Sections 326, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code vide order dated 22-11-2023.

2. Notice of the bail application has been issued to the respondent-complainant and the record of the Ld. Trial Court has also been requisitioned.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the applicants-accused and have gone through the file very carefully.

4. The perusal of file reveals that the applicants-accused have been ordered to be summoned to face trial for the offences punishable under Sections 326, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code vide order dated 22-11-2023 passed by the learned Trial Court. Since, it is a private complaint where only the presence of the applicants-accused is required and their custodial interrogation is not required. The custody of the accused persons during the trial will serve no purpose, as such, the applicants-accused are directed to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within 15 days from today and on their doing so, they shall be admitted to bail by the learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate on furnishing of bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction. In case, the applicants-accused fails to comply with this order, the concession of anticipatory bail granted to the applicants-accused shall stand vacated automatically. Record of Ld. Trial Court be returned back forthwith alongwith copy of this order. Bail

application file be consigned to the Record Room, Ferozepur.
