ORDER

1. This order will dispose of bail application U/s 439 Cr.P.C. moved by applicant/accused in FIR No. 12 dated 05.03.2023, under Sections 21/29/61/85 of ND&PS Act, Police Station Sherpur.

2. Upon notice, it was contested by Addl.P.P. for the State and police record was also produced.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant/accused and learned Addl.P.P. for the State and have gone through the record carefully with their assistance.

4. From perusal of police file, this Court finds that in this case on 05.03.2023, 05 gram Heroin/Chitta was recovered from conscious possession of accused Sinda Singh. Accused/applicant was nominated as an accused in the present case under section 29 of NDPS Act. 05 gram of Heroin/Chitta falls within non commercial quantity and as such, this bail is not hit by section 37 of NDPS Act. Accused is in custody since 05.03.2023. It will take sufficient time for presentation of challan and completion of trial. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused indefinitely in the judicial custody except burden on the state exchequer. Even the accused is not in a position to tamper with the prosecution evidence or to abscond from the court proceedings. As such, without commenting any thing on the merits of the case, bail application is allowed and the applicant/accused Sinda Singh is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds to the tune of ₹25,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court with the condition that applicant/accused will neither leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor she will tamper with the witnesses of the prosecution and she will appear before the learned trial Court on each and every date of

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hearing. Bail application file be attached with the remand papers pending in this Court.
