This petition is coming on before me for final hearing today in the presence of Mr.S.Sabarirajan, B.A., L.L.B., Advocate for the petitioners/ accused and the Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade-II for the respondent/complainant and on perusal of case records, this court delivers the following.

B A I L O R D E R

Both side heard.

The petitioners have filed this petition u/s. 480 of BNSS. to grant bail to them. The petitioners were remanded to judicial custody on **23.05.2026** for the offences u/s. **305(b) BNS** and in connection with the case in **Cr.No.0127/2026** in **Villupuram Town Police Station, Villupuram.**

2. The petitioners/accused stated that the accused were innocent offence and the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the alleged the offence and that the accused ready to furnish substantial sureties to the satisfaction and prayed this Court to release them on bail.

3. Notice was sent to APP and police. Reply received from the APP/Police. In the reply of Police and APP it is stated that the investigation is pending that if the Petitioners / Accused are released on bail may abscond and may involve in similar kind of offences, and try to tamper the witness and destroy the evidence, hence strongly opposed and prayed to dismiss this petition.

4. On perusal of records, the petitioners were arrested and remanded to Judicial Custody on **23.05.2026**, for the offence **U/s. 305(b) BNS**, the accused are in judicial custody from **23.05.2026**, also petitioners has undertaken that they will provide sufficient surety and that they will not abscond, that case property is recovered and on considering the facts and circumstances of this case, this court is inclined to grant bail on condition that the petitioners are released on bail on *executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- along with two sureties for the like sum each and sign before this Respondent Police Station daily at 10.00 a.m. for the period of 4 weeks.*

In the result, this petition is ALLOWED.
