**FIRST BAIL APPLICATION U/S 483 OF BHARATIYA
NAGARIK SURAKSHA SANHITA, 2023**

ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose off the present first bail application filed by above mentioned applicant/accused u/s. 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking regular bail.
2. Upon notice issued to State, Sh. Sukhwant Singh, Ld. Addl.PP for the State has appeared and opposed the bail application. SI Baldev Singh appeared and suffered statement that this is the **1st** bail application under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha

Sanhita, 2023 of applicant/accused. No other bail application has been filed by the applicant/accused in the Court of Sessions or Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court. The applicant/accused was arrested in this case on 14.05.2026. RTFSL report has not been received. However, there is no previous history of the applicant/accused having involved in any criminal case.

3. Learned counsel for applicant has argued that applicant/accused has been falsely implicated in the present case. He is an innocent person. He has further argued that he is in judicial custody since 14.05.2026. The no recovery has already been effected upon the applicant/accused but challan has not been presented in the court. The trial will take long time for its disposal. He prayed for allowing the bail application.

4. On the other hand, learned Addl. PP for State has vehemently opposed the arguments of learned counsel for bail applicant and has submitted that he is a habitual offender and as such, he does not deserve the concession of bail. In last, he prayed that bail application of the applicant may kindly be dismissed.

5. I have heard ld. Counsel for the parties and have carefully perused the record.

6. As per allegations levelled in the FIR, the applicant/accused Bagga Singh alongwith co-accused Gurmej Singh were apprehend by SI Davinder Singh and the present applicant/accused Bagga Singh found in possession of 09 gram heroin alongwith drug money of Rs.1200/- as Indian Currency on the basis of suspicion. The present applicant/accused is coming in judicial custody since 14.05.2026 i.e for a period of about one and half months and his custody is no longer required for further investigation of this case. Presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take long time. However, no useful purpose would be served by detaining him in the custody, rather it will be a burden on state exchequer.

7. Resultantly, the present bail application is allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail subject to furnishing bail bonds

in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount, to the satisfaction of the illaqa/duty Magistrate, subject to the following conditions.

1. That the applicant shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court .
 2. That the applicant will not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
 3. That the applicant will appear on each and every date of hearing to be fixed in the trial.
8. Additional Ahlmad of this court is directed to send a soft copy of this bail order to the applicant/ accused through Jail Superintendent concerned on the official email of the jail as per guidelines dated 31.01.2023 of the Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in Re-policy strategy for grant of bail.
9. A copy of this order be sent to the Court of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate for compliance. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
