**ORDER
(Delivered on 01.05.2026)**

(1) Heard on the application having been moved by applicant Anil Kumar @ Dhalua seeking grant of concession of regular bail in terms of provisions Under Section 483 BNSS in FIR No. 139 dated 22.03.2026 Under Sections 21-B, 27 of NDPS Act, PS City Faridkot.

(2) As per averments made in the application, false case has been registered against accused/ applicant. He is quite innocent. He has nothing to do with alleged crime. Nothing has been recovered from him. Prosecution story is concocted, made up and based on false facts. False case has been planted upon him. The witnesses are interested in prosecution, so there is no question of tampering with their evidence. As such, he should be granted the benefit of bail.

(3) Pursuant to the notice given to the State, the learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State contested the claim of the applicant on the ground that the applicant/accused is involved in a case of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, which is serious in its nature and as such he may not be granted the concession of bail.

(4) The prosecution version in brief is that on 22.03.2026, a police patrolling party apprehended the applicant Anil Kumar @ Dhalua and co-accused Sukhpreet Singh @ Honey and police recovered 08grams heroin along with transparent polythene bag from their possession, without any licence or permit.

(5) During pendency of bail application, SI Rupinder Singh No.3519/PBI Posted at PS City Faridkot appeared and suffered a statement that on 22.03.2026, 08grams heroin along with polythene was recovered from accused/ applicant along with his co-accused. Except present FIR, 09 other FIRs have been registered against accused/ applicant and list of same is Mark A. Accused/ applicant was arrested on 22.03.2026. FSL report is yet to be received in the present case.

(6) The recovery of 08grams heroin along with polybag effected from accused/ applicant and his co-accused, falls within the ambit of non-commercial quantity. The applicant has already spent a substantial period behind bar in this case and presentation of challan and the conclusion of trial will take considerable time. No useful purpose will be served in keeping the applicant behind the bar for indefinite period, rather it will be a burden on State exchequer.

(7) Resultantly, the application is allowed without making any comments upon the merits of the case and the applicant is ordered to be

released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridkot. The bail order is subject to the conditions, as follows :-

1. that the applicant shall attend in accordance with the condition of the bond;
2. that the applicant shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused;
3. that the applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer; and
4. that the applicant shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.

Copy of this order be sent to learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridkot with direction to transmit the bail bonds after acceptance to this Court immediately.

- (8) Police record be returned, immediately. Papers be tagged with remand papers.
