ORDER

1. Present bail application has been moved on behalf of accused/ applicant under Section 439 of Criminal Procedure Code in FIR No.133, dated 15.07.2018, P. S. Kartarpur, Jalandhar under section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act.
2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the prosecution and Shri Harnek Singh Addl. P.P. for the State has appeared on behalf of State.
3. Heard. The alleged recovery effected from the possession of accused/applicant in this case is 20 injections of Avil of 10 ML each and 20 injections of Buprenorphine of 2 ML each. The accused/ applicant has

been arrested in this case on 15.07.2018 and since then he is in custody. Report of Forensic Science Laboratory, Punjab, Mohali, has already been received, as per which, the ingredient of sample (i) in this case qua recovery effected from the possession of accused/applicant is found containing Pheniramine Maleate which does not fall under the ambit of NDPS Act. However, the ingredient of sample (ii) in this case qua recovery effected from the possession of accused are found containing Buprenorphine Hydrochloride. The average weight of per injection is 2 ML whereas total injections are 20. As such, the total weight of 20 injections are i.e. $20 \times 2 = 40$ ML, which is equivalent to 40 grams. More than 20 grams Buprenorphine falls within the ambit of commercial quantity.

4. As such, keeping in view the huge quantity of Buprenorphine Hydrochloride recovered from the possession of accused-applicant, this court is of the considered view that the accused/applicant is not entitled for bail at this stage. So, the instant bail application stands dismissed. Police record be returned and the file of this bail application be tagged with the remand papers.
