

Plaintiffs have filed this suit for the relief of partition and separate possession of their share with respect to the suit schedule properties.

Plaintiffs have filed IA No.I under Order XXXIX Rules 1 & 2 R/w Section 151 of CPC praying to grant the relief of temporary injunction restraining the defendants from alienating the suit schedule properties till the disposal of the suit.

Plaintiffs have prayed to grant the relief of Exparte temporary injunction on IA.I.

Perused the plaint, IA, affidavit and the documents such as family genealogy, copy of sale deeds dated 17.06.1992 and 17.12.1992, Encumbrance certificates, RTC extracts and death certificate of C. Ramakrishnappa.

Except the family genealogy, plaintiffs have not produced any other documents to establish their relationship with late C. Ramakrishnappa. Hence, it is necessary to hear the defendants before passing any orders on I.A.No.I. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:
