

Plaintiffs have filed this suit for the relief of partition and separate possession of their share with respect to the suit schedule properties and for declaration.

Plaintiffs have filed IA No.I under Order XXXIX Rules 1 & 2 R/w Section 151 of CPC praying to grant the relief of temporary injunction restraining the defendants from alienating the suit schedule properties till the disposal of the suit.

Plaintiffs have prayed to grant the relief of Exparte temporary injunction on IA.I.

Perused the plaint, IA, affidavit and the documents such as family genealogy, copies of gift deeds dated 12.05.2026 and RTC extracts.

As this suit is filed for the relief of partition and separate possession, it is necessary to prevent creation of third party interest. If the suit schedule properties are alienated as alleged by the plaintiffs, it will lead to multiplicity of proceedings. Further, object of granting temporary injunction would be defeated by delay, if notice is ordered to the defendants on IA No.I. Hence, dispensing with notice of IA No.I to the defendants, I proceed to pass the following:

### **ORDER**

Issue ex-parte temporary injunction restraining the defendants from alienating the suit schedule properties till the next date of hearing.

Plaintiffs are directed to comply the provisions of Order 39 Rule 3 of CPC.

Issue suit summons, documents and notice of IA No.I to the defendants, returnable by 22.07.2026 at Bangarpet.
