ORDER

The petitioners have filed this petition under Sec.13(3) of Registration of Birth and Death's Act, 1969 for necessary direction to the respondent to enter the death particulars of Sri.Raman.P., S/o Padavattan and Chinnammal, who has demised on 09.02.2011 in the register of death and to issue death Certificate of petitioners father.

2. In the petition the Petitioners have stated that, their father by name Sri.Raman.P., S/o Padavattan and Chinnammal who has demised on 09.02.2011 at #21, H Block, Champion Reefs [p], KGF Taluk (home). Further stated that the said information was not intimated to the respondent in time and they were not aware of the same. Now the petitioners requires the Death Certificate of their father to submit the same to Revenue Authorities for documentation and domestic purpose. In this regard petitioners have approached the respondent office and they have issued a Non-availability Certificate dated 11.03.2026. Hence petitioners prays to allow the petition.

3. In spite of service of notice and public notice in two daily Newspapers, the Respondent and no other claimants did not appear before the Court, hence respondent placed as ex-parte and the matter posted for petitioners evidence.

4. In order to prove their case, the petitioner No.1 by name Sri.Thyagaraj.R has examined himself as PW.1 and documents were got marked as Ex.P.1 to P.14, 14(a). The counsel for petitioners submits that they have no further evidence, hence further evidence of petitioners side taken as closed. Since the respondent placed as ex-parte, the cross examination of PW1 and respondent evidence taken as nil and the matter posted for arguments.

5. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and perused the documents available on record.

6. The points that arise for my consideration are;

1. Whether the Petitioners would be entitle for the relief sought in the petition?

2. What order?

7. My findings to the above points are;

Point No. 1 : In the Affirmative,

Point No. 2 : As per my final order for the following;

REASONS

8. **Point No.1** : It is case of the Petitioners that their father by name Sri.Raman.P., S/o Padavattan and Chinnammal who has demised on 09.02.2011 at #21, H Block, Champion Reefs [p],

KGF Taluk (home). Further they have not registered the death particulars of said Sri.Raman.P to the concerned authority in time, due to lack of knowledge.

9. In support of their case, the petitioner No.1 by name Sri.Thyagaraj.R has examined himself as PW1 by filing his chief affidavit and reiterated the petition averments. Further PW1 has produced documents as Ex.P.1 to P.14 and 14(a). In that Ex.P1 is the Non-availability Certificate issued by the respondent on 11.03.2026 which shows that they have approached the respondent. Further Ex.P2 is the notarized copy of Adhaar Card of PW1 which shows that his father name is mentioned as Raman. Further Ex.P3 is the notarized copy of petitioner No.2. Further Ex.P4 is the notarized copy of Adhar Card of petitioner No.3. Further Ex.P5 is the notarized copy of Adhaar Card of Petitioner No.4 which shows that his father name is mentioned as Raman. Further Ex.P6 is the notarized copy of Death Certificate of Anandraj.R who is the son of Raman and Dhanabakiam which shows that he has demised on 08.01.2018. Further Ex.P7 is the notarized copy of Affidavit of Genealogical Tree of Thiruvvasagi and Late Anandraj.R. Further Ex.P8 is the notarized copy of Death Certificate of R.Kempuraj, who is the son of Raman and Dhanabakyam, which shows that he has demised on 20.10.2025. Further Ex.P9 is the notarized copy of Affidavit of Genealogical Tree of petitioner No.2. Further Ex.P10 is the notarized copy of Death Certificate of Kantharaj.R, who is the son of Raman and Dhanabakyam, which shows that he has demised on

20.02.2023. Further Ex.P11 is the notarized copy of Affidavit of Genealogical Tree of Kalaiselvi. Further Ex.P12 is the notarized copy of Death Certificate of Dhanabakiam, who is the wife of Raman, which shows that she has demised on 17.12.1980. Further Ex.P13 is the is News trail daily newspaper publication dated 09.06.2026 and Ex.P.13(a) is operative portion of said news paper. Further Ex.P.14 is the Kolara Kirana daily newspaper publication dated 07.06.2026 and Ex.P.14(a) is operative portion of said news paper. The above said documents corroborates the contents of petition.

10. On perusal of the oral testimony of PW1 and documents it shows that their father name is Raman.P. Further the respondent has placed exparte, hence the testimony of petitioners have remained unchallenged and un-contraverted and there are no reasons to disbelieve the evidence given by the petitioners. Further after the paper publication no one has raised any objection for the prayer of the petitioners. Moreover the documents furnished by them are corroborates with each other. Hence it is proper to issue direction to the respondent to record the date of death of Sri.Raman.P., S/o Padavattan and Chinnammal who has demised on 09.02.2011 at #21, H Block, Champion Reefs [p], KGF Taluk (home). Accordingly, I answer **Point No.1** in the **Affirmative**.

11. Point No. 2 : In view of my aforesaid findings, I proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

The Petition filed by the petitioners under Sec.13(3) of Register of Birth and Death's Act is hereby allowed.

Consequently, the respondent is hereby directed to enter the death of Sri.Raman.P., S/o Padavattan and Chinnammal, who has demised on 09.02.2011 at #21, H Block, Champion Reefs [p], KGF Taluk (home) in the death register and issue death Certificate after collecting necessary fee.
