ORDER

1. Accused/ applicant Pappu Ram has filed the present bail application under section 439 Cr.PC in case FIR No.02 dated 04.01.2022 U/s 22 of NDPS Act, Police Station: Bareta, District Mansa.

2. Accusation leading to the registration of the FIR above said, are that on 04.01.2022, SI Satnam Singh received information from MHC that ASI Pargat Singh alongwith police party was going in connection with the patrolling. They had apprehended one person near Grain Market, Bareta on the suspicion that he might be carrying some intoxicant

substance. On receiving the information, SI Satnam Singh received at the spot. On enquiry, the apprehended person disclosed his name as Pappu Ram aged about 50 years, son of Dara Ram, resident of Bajigar Basti Krishnagar Chinrathal, District Bathinda. Recovery of 1920 tablets of Alprasafe 0.5 was effected from his possession. He was arrested in the present case. On this narration, present case was registered.

3. It has been argued by learned defence counsel for the on behalf of the accused/ applicant that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. He is in custody since 04.01.2022. On these averments besides usual grounds, the accused/applicant was asked to be released on bail.

4. The application has been opposed by the learned Addl. PP for the State.

5. I have heard the arguments of learned counsel for the applicant/accused, learned Addl. PP for the State and have gone through the police record with their able assistance.

6. As per the allegations of the prosecution, on 04.01.2022, the accused/ applicant Pappu Ram was found in possession of 1920 tablets of Alprasafe 0.5. Report of Chemical Examiner has been received. By going through the Report of Chemical Examiner, it reveals that one parcel containing 10 tablets of Alprasafe 0.5 on being analyzed by the Chemical Analyst, the ingredients of that parcel were found containing Alprazolam. The weight of each tablet was 121.37 mg and thus, the total weight of 1920 tablets comes to $1920 \times 121.27 \text{ mg} / 1000 = 233.03 \text{ gms}$ approximately of intoxicant substance containing Alprazolam. The salt

“Alprazolam” is mentioned at serial No.178 of the table in NDPS Act. The contraband recovered from the accused falls under commercial quantity as per provision of the NDPS Act. The allegations against the applicant/ accused are serious in nature. With deep concern, it is pointed out that the organized activities of the underworld led to drug addiction among a sizeable section of the public, particularly the adolescents and students of both sexes and the menace has assumed serious and alarming proportions in the recent years. Therefore, in order to effectively control and eradicate this proliferating and booming devastating menace, causing deleterious effects and deadly impact on the society as a whole. This court finds no justification to grant bail to the applicant/ accused. Hence, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the bail application under reference filed by the applicant/ accused Pappu Ram is dismissed. Police record be returned and the papers of this bail application be tagged with main file.
