BAIL APPLICATION UNDER SECTION 483 of B.N.S.S.

ORDER

The above named accused has filed this application for the
grant of regular bail under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha
Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as B.N.S.S.), in the afore referred
F.I.R.

2. The very substance of the application being that accused/applicant had been falsely implicated in this case. He is innocent and has never committed any offence. False recovery had been foisted upon the accused-applicant.

3. Pursuant to the notice to the State, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State contested the claim of the applicant on the ground that the accused/applicant is culpable under the stringent provisions of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and consequently should be denied the concession of bail.

4. It was submitted by ASI Balbir Singh, no other FIR has been registered against accused. Ahlmad has reported that this is the first bail application of accused. Apart from that, no other bail application is pending or decided by any Superior Court. Record was produced.

5. 7 grams of heroin alongwith drug money of Rs.1000/- is stated to have been recovered from accused/applicant. Challan is yet to be presented.

6. Evidently, the recovered heroin falls within the range of intermediate quantity and is not commercial by any accounts. The accused/applicant is already in custody since 03.02.2026 and conclusion of trial will take its own course and time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused indefinitely.

7. Hence in the peculiar circumstances, the accused-applicant is ordered to be released on ***bail*** on his furnishing bail

bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That he shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing;*
- 2. That he shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected;*
- 3. That he shall not directly or indirectly make an inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence; and*
- 4. That he shall not leave the country without prior permission of Court.*

8. In view of the above, it is clarified that the observations made herein above are limited for the purpose of present proceedings and would not be construed as any opinion on the merits of the case. Papers be annexed with the main challan/record. Police record be returned forthwith.
