Order:

This order of mine shall dispose of an application filed on behalf of applicant/accused Amritpreet Singh.

Heard on the bail application moved by the learned counsel for the applicant/accused. It has been argued by him that the applicant/accused is in judicial custody since 03.04.2026. He has been falsely implicated in the present case. It has been further argued that accused is quite innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR. He is no more required in the custody for any purpose of the investigation. Hence the present bail application be allowed.

Notice of the bail application given to the State through the learned APP for the State, who has opposed the bail application orally by stating that the offence in the instant FIR is grave in nature, keeping in view the gravity of the offence, the applicant/accused Amritpreet Singh is not entitled to the concession of the bail. With the submission he has prayed for dismissal of the application.

I have heard the counsel for the applicant/accused as well as learned APP for the State and perused the judicial file. Perusal of the judicial file reveals that the accusation levelled against the applicant/accused are serious in nature as he has allegedly caused grievous injury with datar. So, keeping in view the gravity of the offence alleged to have been committed by the applicant/accused, no ground of releasing him on bail is made out and as such bail application filed on behalf of applicant/accused Amritpreet Singh is hereby dismissed being without merits.
