**ORDER:-**

1. Heard on 1<sup>st</sup> regular bail application filed on behalf of accused

**Jaspreet Singh @ Jolly.**

2. As per the prosecution version, on 04.05.2025, at about 11.50  
PM, in the area of T point Dhunda Bypass, Bassi Pathana, the accused was  
found in possession of 100 tablets Alprazolam 0.5 mg from black  
polythene bag which he had thrown on the road on seeing the police party.

3. As per reply filed today, the FSL report is yet to be received.

There is no record of criminal antecedents of accused under NDPS Act. He

is in custody since 04.05.2025. As per case law titled as ***Inderjit Singh @ Laddy vs State of Punjab 2014 (3)-RCR (Criminal)- 953***, wherein Division Bench of our own Hon'ble High Court has been pleased to hold that if matter is being unnecessarily delayed due to non-receipt of FSL Report, Special Court may release applicant/accused on interim bail till receipt of report of Chemical Examiner. Therefore, taking into consideration all the circumstances, the accused/applicant is ordered to be released on **interim bail** on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of Ld.Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, subject to following conditions:-

1. That he shall attend Court on each and every date of hearing;
2. That he shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected;
3. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence;  
and
4. That he shall not leave the country without prior permission of Court.
5. That he shall surrender in the court if the intoxicant recovered from him falls under commercial quantity.

4. This order will remain operative subject to the receipt of report from chemical Examiner as to contents of Intoxicant tablets and in

the event of the contents of intoxicant substance being found to be commercial quantity, this order of interim bail shall become inoperative otherwise the interim bail would be deemed to have been confirmed. File be consigned to record room, Fatehgarh Sahib.
