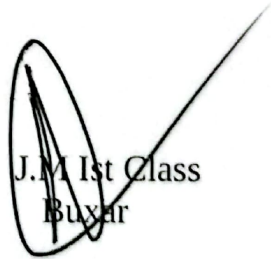

	01/02/2024	Both complainant and inquiry witnesses are absent. Perused the case record. From sincere perusal of the complaint it appears that the present complaint has been filed by the complainant Shree Ram Paswan against accused persons namely (1)Shree Bhagwan Sah (2)Mantosh Sah (3)Chotu Sah for the offences punishable u/s 323, 324, 379, 504, 506/34 of Indian Penal Code. The case record received on transfer to the present court on 21.06.2023 for disposal as per law . On perusal of the case record, it appears that complainant is absent since inception of this case and has not made any proper pairvi ever in this case. He also fail to examine himself upon oath. Despite of several opportunity and direction, complainant did not turn up for recording solemn affirmation. This shows that complainant has lost his interest in the case. Due to continuous absence of the complainant and lack of proper pairvi either by the complainant or his advocate it is difficult to proceed with inquiry. So inquiry evidence is hereby closed. Perused the complainant petition and case record, on perusal this court find that neither complainant nor any inquiry witnesses have been examined in support of this case thus this court is of view that due to lack of supporting evidence and materials there is no sufficient ground for proceeding in this case. Hence the complaint is hereby dismissed u/s 203 of Cr.P.C. O.C is directed to consign the case record within stipulated time period in accordance with law.  J.M Ist Class Buxar
