

No representation for Decree holder.

Arrest warrant has again returned un executed stating that JDr No.1 is not found in the given address.

In view of the directions given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Para 42 in the case of ***Rahul S Shah V/s Jinendra Kumar Gandhi and Others (2021) 6 SCC 418*** and also subsequently in the case of ***Bhoj Raj Garg V/s Goyal Education and Welfare Society and Others arising out of SLP (C) No. 19654/2022 dated: 18-11-2022*** and also in view of Circular No. 2/2025 of Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka, Bengaluru dated: 01-04-2025, the Execution Petitions are to be disposed within **06 months from the date of filing.**

The Decree holder has not taken effective steps to realize the award amount.

The Attachment Warrant of movables issued earlier had returned un executed for want of valuables.

The arrest warrant issued several times is also not executed.

Therefore taking the note of the fact that sufficient opportunities are given and also in view of the ratio laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in the above case, the following is made;

ORDER

Execution petition is
dismissed for default.
