

Amendment is carried out and furnished the amended plaint.

At this stage, counsel for plaintiff filed IA No.12 U/O 6 rule 17 R/W Sec.151 of CPC, seeking permission to amend the plaint i.e., for deletion of the property No.8 and 9 from this case.

Counsel for defendants endorsed no objection to allow the IA No.12.

Heard the argument, perused and satisfied, IA is allowed, accordingly counsel for plaintiff is permitted to amend the plaint as prays for.

Mean time amendment is carried out and furnished the amended plaint and submitted that matter will compromise.

At this stage, plaintiff is present, defendant No.1 to 6 are also present, further their counsels Sri. SVK, Sri. RRP and Sri. MBB, are also present. At this stage matter is compromised.

Furnished compromise petition U/O 23 rule 3 of CPC, Contents of compromise petition is read over and explained to both the parties in open court, they have shown their

satisfaction.

It is noticed that, very compromise is not illegal and there is no legal impediment to accept the compromise petition.

Hence, this court proceed to pass the following,

ORDER

Compromise petition furnished by the counsel for plaintiff and defendants is hereby accepted.

Accordingly suit of the plaintiff is here by decreed in terms of compromise petition.

Parties have to bear their own cost.

Draw final decree in terms of compromise petition.

Note: Parties are directed to register the decree before the Sub-Registrar Koppal prior to passing of any mutation entry on the basis of this decree.
