ORDER ON MAIN PETITION

The Petitioner has filed this petition seeking issuance of directions to respondent to enter the date of birth of his daughter's by name **Suprita D/o Suresh Harijan born on 29.03.2016 at Gabbur, Tq. & Dist: Koppal.**

2. The Petition notice to the Respondent was duly served. In spite of service of Notice, the Respondent did not appear.

3. The Petitioner has been himself examined as PW-1 and got marked Ex.P-1 to P-4. Ex.P-1 is the Non-availability certificate, Ex.P.2 and 3 are the Original Adhar Card of petitioner and his wife, Ex.P-4 is the original School Certificate of the daughter of the petitioner. PW-1 has reiterated the contents of the Petition in his examination in chief. As the Respondent did not choose to appear, the evidence of PW-1 remained unchallenged. Hence, there is nothing available on record to disbelieve the version stated by the PW-1 on oath.

4. Apart from this, the explanation given by the PW.1 for non-informing the date of birth to the concerned authorities is also satisfactory one. PW-1 is the competent person to say regarding the his daughter's birth. Hence, in my opinion the Petitioner has made out grounds to issue directions to the Respondent authority as prayed in the petition. Hence, I pass the following:

ORDER

The Petition filed under Section 13(3) of Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 by the Petitioner is hereby allowed.

The Respondent shall register the date of birth of **Suprita D/o Suresh Harijan** born on **29.03.2016** at **Gabbur, Tq. & Dist: Koppal.** and shall issue the birth certificate to the Petitioner by collecting prescribed fee.

Issue intimation to the Respondent to issue Birth Certificate as directed above by collecting necessary fee and fine.

It is made clear that the mention of date of birth herein is not in the nature of declaration.
