

ORDER

Case is called out.

Petitioner is present. Advocate for petitioner and advocate for respondent are present.

Both parties and their counsels have filed joint memo. As per the joint memo, the respondent Insurance authority has agreed to pay the compensation amount of Rs. 3,25,000/- (Rs. Three lakh Twenty five thousand only) to the petitioner. Petitioner has agreed the same. The respondent Insurance authority has also agreed to deposit the said amount within 3 months from the date of the award.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submit to release entire compensation amount to the petitioner.

Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for petitioner, out of deposited amount, entire amount shall be released in favour of petitioner through K-2 with proper identification.

As the petitioner has not furnished her bank account details to the court so far, she is directed to furnish same particulars to the Respondent-Insurance Company. The said Insurance Company is hereby directed to credit the above said released amount to Bank Account of the Petitioner through RTGS or NEFT, if she could not furnish her bank account particulars and other relevant documents like Adhar Card, Pan Card etc., to the insurance company within one month from the date of award. There after directed the Respondent Insurance Company to deposit the settled amount to this MACT within the stipulated period.

Office is directed to draw the award as per terms of joint memo.

Terms of award are part and parcel of joint memo.
