Chief examination : by Public Prosecutor.

- 1) Since November 2011 I have been working in different positions at RFSL Mysuru and I am working as Assistant Director at Biology section, at RFSL, Mysuru.
- 2) On 22.10.2020, our office received 15 sealed articles from Mandya West Police Station, relating this case, through Siddappa Hugar – PC 99 of Mandya West Police Station. The said articles were registered at our office No.RFSL/BS/718/2020. The said articles were sent to our Biology section.

3) I received the said articles and those articles were duly packed and sealed. The seals were tallied with the sample sealed sent by the IO.

4) While I opened the articles, I found :

- i. Item No.1: One stone.
- ii. Item No.2: One wooden club.
- iii. Item No.3: One wooden club.
- iv. Item No.4: One Macchu.
- v. Item No.5 : One Kudugolu
- vi. Item No.6 : One Kudugolu
- vii. Item No.7 : Mud
- viii. Item No.8 : Sample Mud
- ix. Item No:9: One night pant
- x. Item No.10: One pant.
- xi. Item No.11: One Baniyan
- xii. Item No.12: One night pant
- xiii. Item No.13 : One T-Shirt.
- xiv. Item No.14 : One Baniyan
- xv. Item No.15: One night pant.

5) I subjected the aforesaid articles were for chemical and serological examination. After my examination, I found, except article No.8, all other articles were stained with human blood, and article No.1, 3, 4, 9, 11 and 12 were stained with 'A' group

blood, and articles No.2,5,6,7,10,13, 14 and 15 were stained with 'AB' group blood.

- 6) I prepared the report opining as aforesaid and handed over to our Deputy Director to forward the said report and the articles to concerned I.O.
- 7) Now I can identify the FSL report, sample seal and the articles examined my me. The witness identified FSL report and sample seal. FSL report with the sample seal is already marked as Ex.P.98 and signature of the witness is marked as Ex.P98(b), (c), (d) and (e).
- 8) The witness identified her signature on the slips pasted on the MO.1-club, MO3-Macchu, MO.4 and MO.5- Two Kudugolu's, and MO.6-stone, MO.7 and 8- plastic bottles containing mud and sample mud, MO.9- Baniyan, MO.10-Baniyan, MO.11-Night Pant, MO.12-Night Pant, MO.13-T.Shirt, MO.14-pant, MO.15- Night pant. However, the said slip is not found in the cloth cover of MO.2. The signatures in the slips pasted on MO.1,3 to 15 are marked as MO.1(c), MO.3(c), MO.4(c), MO.5(c), MO.6(c),MO.7(c), MO.8(c), MO.9(c), MO.10(c), MO.11(c), MO.12(c), MO.13(c), MO.14(c) and MO.15(c) marked. The witness identified seals of FSL on the said articles MO.1 to MO.15.

Cross examination by Sri. BRV, Advocate for A1, A4 to 7 :

9) We used to cut the suspected portion of the cloths for examination. In this case also I have done same procedure. At the 1st stage of examination, we used to mark the suspected area of the cloths. We conduct the serological examination in two stages. It is false to suggest that, the scrapping obtained would not support for serological examination. I have identified the sustained portion in M.O.4 and 5 – kudugolu's. It is false to suggest that, there would be difference in the natural blood stains over the article and sprinkled blood stains on the article. It is true to suggest that, the investigating officer has not produced the sample blood of 'A', 'AB' blood group. It is false to suggest that, IO has not produced MO1 to 15 articles. It is false to suggest that, I have not examined MO1 to 15 articles. It is false to suggest that, I issued the Ex.P98 report on the influence of the police though I have not examined any articles.
