Chief examination : by Public Prosecutor.

- 1) Since 5 years I am working as Consultant Maxillofacial surgeon, at Astra Super specialty Hospital Bengauru.
- 2) On 30.09.2020, PW2— Swamy brought to our hospital with intubation. He was unconscious, while he was brought to our hospital. I found injuries at the lower chin, forehead, infratemporal region of PW2. Blood oozed from the nose and mouth. There was edema over the face of PW2.
- 3) After C.T. brain and face, I found SDH over right fronto perital region, right frontal haemorrhagic contusions in the brain.

- 4) I found multiple comminuted fractures over mandible and bilateral maxillary region.
- 5) After neuro surgeon and nephrologist opinion, I conducted the surgery to PW2 swamy on 01.10.2020. After surgery, patient again referred to neuro surgeon and nephrologist for further management on 25.10.2020. I advised to discharge the patient once he become stable.
- 6) The Learned Public Prosecutor has shown 8 photographs to the witness and witness stated that, those photographs snapped by him at the time of surgery and gave to patient's attendant on his request. (Since the required certificate u.sec.65-B of Indian Evidence Act, those photographs are not marked as prosecution exhibits).
- 7) Till 6.11.2025, I followed up the patient PW2 -Swamy. He has got complaints regarding previous procedure and incident occurred 5 years ago. I advised him to obtain further treatment for implant removals and dental rehabilitation pertaining to the injuries occurred in the incident.
- 8) The injuries noted by me on the face and head of Swamy could be caused by MO.6 - size stone. The witness identified the out patient records and discharge note and the x-ray. 16 pages of out patient record and discharge note is collectively marked as Ex.P.99. X-ray is marked as Ex.P.100.

Cross examination by : Sri. B.R.V. advocate for accused

NO.1, 4 to 7 :

10) I received the phone call from the casualty department of Astra Speciality Hospital for the facial treatment swamy. Dri. Sridhar – PW12 initially treated the patient Swamy at the Astra hospital.

Question : Facial surgery has to be conducted during conscious condition of the patient ?.

Answer : It depends upon the nature of injuries sustained.

11) It is false to suggest that, Swamy-PW2 has not referred for facial surgery.

Question : The facial and forehead injuries sustained by Swamy could be caused by fall ?

Answer : Such injuries may or may not caused by fall. In my opinion, the injuries sustained by PW2 Swamy by assault.

12) If a person falls from 20 feet height he could sustain crush injury. It is false to suggest that, I am treating PW 2- Swamy now also. It is false to suggest that, since PW2 is a patient of Astra Hospital, I am deposing falsely.
