

Accused, P.P. and Sri. NLM Advocate present.

Sri. NLM Advocate filed vakalath for Accused and submitted that Accused is ready to settle the case by paying penalty.

In the complaint and enclosures geologist alleged that on 17.02.2025 along with colleagues, junior engineer, village administrative officer, Maddur village when inspected land bearing Sy.No.624/1 of Maddur village came to know that prior to 17.02.2025 Accused illegally transported 9 Alankarika Stone Block weighing about 142.24 metric ton royalty worth of Rs.56,896/-.

Copy of the order dated 04.04.2019 passed in W.P.54183-54185/2018 (GM-MM-S) shows that the Honorable High Court of Karnataka directed the complainant department to shift stone within 8 weeks.

Sri.NLM Advocate and P.P. on verification of the records

determined the penalty at Rs.5,000/- (five thousand).

It is directed to office to collect Rs.5,000/- (five thousand) from Accused as penalty issue suitable receipt make entry in the order sheet.
