Examination in chief by the Spl. Public Prosecutor.

1. From 01.04.2021 I am working as Gynecologist at Sub-Divisional Hospital, Pandavapura.
2. On 25.01.2022 at 7.00 PM I have examined a patient by name Mallikarjuna, aged 37 years, who came with 3 others with a history of assault.
3. The patient himself gave me the history that he was assaulted at around 6.30 PM near Gnanabandu Cross, Devegowdanakoppalu Village by 7 – 8 persons.
4. On examination I did not find any visible external injuries. He complained of chest pain and jaw pain, right shoulder pain. I referred for CT Scan, Ultra Sound scan as well as x-ray.

5. After examination I have issued the wound Certificate which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.7** and the signature is marked as **Ex.P-7(a)**.
6. At the time of examination I have noted in the MLC Register. Now I am shown the copy of MLC Extract which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.8**.
7. In my opinion the injuries noted are simple in nature and if any persons is assaulted with MO.2 and 3 wooden clubs and man handled the pains complained of could be caused as alleged in the history.
8. On the same day at 7.20 PM I have examined a patient by name Nanjaiah, aged 46 years, who came with 3 others with a history of assault.
9. The patient himself gave me the history that he was assaulted at around 6.30 PM near Gnanabandu Cross, Devegowdanakoppalu Village by 7 – 8 persons.
10. On examination I found deep punctured wound with oozing on the dorsal aspect of the right hand and right middle finger, tenderness over the left hypochondrium and right para umbilical region. I referred the patient to higher centre, but the patient did not go.
11. After examination I have issued the wound Certificate which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.9** and the signature is marked as **Ex.P-9(a)**.
12. At the time of examination I have noted in the MLC Register. Now I am shown the copy of MLC Extract which

bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.10.**

13. In my opinion the injuries noted are simple in nature and if any person is assaulted with MO.1 iron rod and man handled the injuries noted could be caused as alleged in the history.
14. On the dame day at 7.40 PM I have examined a patient by name Premananda, aged 40 years, who came with 3 others with a history of assault.
15. The patient himself gave me the history that he was assaulted at around 6.30 PM near Gnanabandu Cross, Devegowdanakoppalu Village by 7 – 8 persons.
16. On examination I noted swelling of the right forearm anterior and lateral aspect.
17. After examination I have issued the wound Certificate which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.11** and the signature is marked as **Ex.P-11(a).**
18. At the time of examination I have noted in the MLC Register. Now I am shown the copy of MLC Extract which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.12.**
19. In my opinion the injury noted is simple in nature and if any person is assaulted with MO.2 and 3 wooden clubs and man handled the injury noted could be caused as alleged in the history.
20. On the same day at 9.00 PM I have examined a patient by name Kumar, aged 42 years, who came with 3 others with a history of assault.

21. The patient himself gave me the history that he was assaulted at around 6.30 PM near Gnanabandu Cross, Devegowdanakoppalu Village by 7 – 8 persons.
22. On examination I found swelling over the right frontal region measuring 3 x 4 CM. I referred the patient for CT Scan. No significant trauma related intracranial abnormality found.
23. After examination I have issued the wound Certificate which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.13** and the signature is marked as **Ex.P-13(a)**.
24. At the time of examination I have noted in the MLC Register. Now I am shown the copy of MLC Extract which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.14**.
25. In my opinion the injury noted are simple in nature and if any persons is assaulted with MO.2 and 3 wooden clubs and man handled the pains complained of could be caused as alleged in the history.

Cross – examination: Sri MNV Adv. for Accused Nos. 1 to 5:

26. Along with Nanjaiah, Premananda and Kumar, Mallikarjuna the first patient had accompanied. In Ex.P.9, 11 and 13 Wound Certificates the age of injuries are not noted, witness volunteers the deep punctured wound with oozing noted in Ex.P.9 itself shows it is fresh in nature and with respect to the swelling noted in Ex.P.11 and 13 age cannot be mentioned.

27. In all the MLC register extracts the history noted shows that the incident occurred near Gnangabandu School circle. CC TV Camaras are installed inside as well as outside the hospital. Usually there will be patients, staff during 7.00 PM to 9.00 PM in the hospital. It is not true to suggest that Duty police will be available all the time in the hospital.
28. If any untoward incident occurs inside the hospital premises the same would be intimated to our higher authorities and also to the concerned Police Station. No untoward incident has occurred within the hospital premises on 25.01.2022 in connection with these 4 patients between 7.00 PM and 9.00 PM. It is true to suggest that complains of pain can be pretended. It is true to suggest that if any persons skids from a moving two wheeler the injuries noted in the Wound Certificates could be caused. At the time of treatment all the 4 patients were conscious. I have issued Wound Certificates as per the medical guidelines after referring to Specialist opinion.
