An application for grant of bail on behalf of accused persons has
been moved. Notice given to Learned APP for the State. Ld. APP for the state
opted not to file reply. Arguments heard on bail application moved on behalf of
accused. Perusal of the case file reveals that trial of the case is likely to take
considerable long time and moreover, no fruitful purpose would be served by
keeping the accused persons in custody. In the light of the law laid down by
Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar, 2014 (8) SCC 273, accused are admitted to bail
on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 40,000/- each with one surety in the
like amount. Requisite bail bonds and surety bonds on behalf of the accused
furnished, which are accepted and attested. Accused persons be released
forthwith if not required in any other case. Application stands disposed off
accordingly. Accused be released forthwith, if not required in any other case.
