Examination in chief by the Spl. Public Prosecutor.

1. From 13.05.2016 till date I am working as CMO at MIMS, Mandya.
2. On 30.08.2019 at 5.35 PM I have examined a patient by name Rathnamma aged 55 years, who was brought by WPC P.K.Radha of Mandya West Police Station with a history of assault.
3. The patient herself gave me the history that on 30.08.2019 at 12.30 PM at 6th Cross, Gandinagar, she was hit by H.M.Shashidara and others using legs, hands and wooden sticks.
4. On examination I found the injuries noted below;
 - a) Tenderness over left hand, chest, right knee
 - b) Tenderness over right thigh.

5. After examination I have issued the wound Certificate which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.14** and the signature is marked as **Ex.P-14(a)**.
6. In my opinion the injuries noted are simple in nature and injuries noted could be caused if a person is assaulted with MO.1 Stick and by using hands and legs.
7. On the same day at 5.40 PM I have examined a patient by name Maneyamma aged 90 years, who was also brought by WPC P.K.Radha of Mandya West Police Station with a history of assault.
8. The patient herself gave me the history that on 30.08.2019 at 12.30 PM at 6th Cross, Gandinagar, she was pushed by H.M.Shashidara and others.
9. On examination I found the tenderness over the right knee.
10. After examination I have issued the wound Certificate which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.15** and the signature is marked as **Ex.P-15(a)**.
11. In my opinion the injury noted is simple in nature and injury noted could be caused if a person is pushed own.
12. On the same day at 5.45 PM I have examined a patient by name Kenchamma aged 50 years, who was also brought by WPC P.K.Radha of Mandya West Police Station with a history of assault.
13. The patient herself gave me the history that on 30.08.2019 at 12.30 PM at 6th Cross, Gandinagar, she was assaulted using brick by H.M.Shashidara and others.
14. On examination I found tenderness over left chest and left hip.

15. After examination I have issued the wound Certificate which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.16** and the signature is marked as **Ex.P-16(a)**.
16. In my opinion the injury noted is simple in nature and injury noted could be caused if a person is assaulted with MO.2 and 3 Cement bricks and by using hands and legs.
17. On the same day at 5.50 PM I have examined a patient by name Rajeshwari aged 35 years, who was brought by WPC P.K.Radha of Mandya West Police Station with a history of assault.
18. The patient herself gave me the history that on 30.08.2019 at 12.30 PM at 6th Cross, Gandinagar, she was pushed by H.M.Shashidara and others.
19. On examination I found tenderness over abdomen, right thigh, right arm, and right forearm, left forearm,
20. After examination I have issued the wound Certificate which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.17** and the signature is marked as **Ex.P-17(a)**.
21. In my opinion the injuries noted are simple in nature and injuries noted could be caused if a person is man handled by several persons and pushed down.
22. On the same day at 5.55 PM I have examined a patient by name Jayarama, aged 30 years, who was brought by WPC P.K.Radha of Mandya West Police Station with a history of assault.
23. The patient himself gave me the history that on 30.08.2019 at 12.30 PM at 6th Cross, Gandinagar, he was pushed by H.M.Shashidara and others.

24. On examination I found tenderness over left arm and left forearm.
25. After examination I have issued the wound Certificate which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.18** and the signature is marked as **Ex.P-18(a)**.
26. In my opinion the injuries noted are simple in nature and injuries noted could be caused if a person is man handed and pushed down.
27. On the same day at 6.00 PM I have examined a patient by name Jayamma aged 45 years, who was brought by WPC P.K.Radha of Mandya West Police Station with a history of assault.
28. The patient herself gave me the history that on 30.08.2019 at 12.30 PM at 6th Cross, Gandinagar, she was assaulted by H.M.Shashidara and others using hands.
29. On examination I found tenderness over chest, back, over scalp.
30. After examination I have issued the wound Certificate which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.19** and the signature is marked as **Ex.P-19(a)**.
31. In my opinion the injuries noted are simple in nature and injuries noted could be caused if a person is man handed by several persons and assaulted by using hands.
32. On the same day at 6.10 PM I have examined a patient by name Puttamadaiah aged 60 years, who was brought by WPC P.K.Radha of Mandya West Police Station with a history of assault.

33. The patient himself gave me the history that on 30.08.2019 at 12.30 PM at 6th Cross, Gandinagar, he was pushed by H.M.Shashidara and others.
34. On examination I found the tenderness over chest and over both elbows.
35. After examination I have issued the wound Certificate which bears my signature and seal which is now marked as **Ex.P.20** and the signature is marked as **Ex.P-20(a)**.
36. In my opinion the injuries noted are simple in nature and injuries noted could be caused if a person is man handled and pushed down.

Cross – examination: Sri. HDR., Adv. for Accused:

37. I have not noted who had given the history in the respective Wound Certificates. In Ex.P. 14 to 20 Wound Certificates I have not mentioned the designation of the person who had brought the Victims to hospital except a name P.K.Radha. I have not noted the colour of tenderness said to be found on the bodies of patients mentioned in Ex.P. 14 to 20 Wound Certificates.
38. As per the medical manual there are two types of tenderness. One is physical tenderness and the other one is emotional tenderness which is not visible. I have not noted the dimension of the tenderness in the Wound Certificates. I have not noted the type of tenderness whether it was muscle tenderness or joint tenderness in the Wound Certificates. Usually the tenderness which is not visible will be noted in the Wound Certificates as told by the patients.
39. None of the patients have got X-rays done despite I had advised for X-ray. Before issuing the Wound Certificates I got to know that the patients did not get the X-rays done. I have not

noted the age of the injuries in the Wound Certificates. Since there was no visible injuries I did not mention the age of the injuries. It is true to suggest that tenderness can be pretended. It is not true to suggest that there were no tenderness on the bodies of the patients as I have mentioned in Ex.P. 14 to 20.

40. I did not enquire the person who brought the patients to hospital whether any case was registered with respect to the history given by the patients. It is not true to suggest that the history noted in the Wound Certificates was given by the person P.K.Radha who accompanied the patients.

41. After issuing the Wound Certificates the Investigating Officer did not conduct any enquiry with me by showing any weapon. It is not true to suggest that I have not given any treatment to the patients. It is not true to suggest that I have given a false Wound Certificates as per the instigation of Investigating Officer.
