J U D G M E N T

Senior Civil Judge and JMFC, Malavalli committed C.C.607/2025 registered for the offences punishable under Section 103 of B.N.S. on the basis of the final report submitted in Cr.No.133/2025 by Malavalli Rural Police.

2. Since 11.05 p.m. of 31.07.2025 accused is in judicial custody.



3. After hearing submission made on behalf of both the parties and on the basis of the materials available in the file on 29.01.2026 charges of the offence punishable under Section 103 of B.N.S., 2023 (Section 302 of IPC) has been framed, then, read over and explained to the accused, for which accused has pleaded not guilty.

4. To prove charges levelled against accused prosecution examined 10 witnesses as PW-1 to PW-10, get marked 32 documents, 27 signatures at Ex.P.1 to 31, Ex.P.1(a), Ex.P.2(a),(b), Ex.P.5(a), Ex.P.6(a), Ex.P.7(a), Ex.8(a), (b), Ex.P.9(a),(b), Ex.P.10(a),(b),(c), Ex.P.11(a),(b), Ex.P.12(a), Ex.P.13(a), Ex.P.14 (a), Ex.P.22(a), Ex.P.23(a), Ex.P.24(a), Ex.P.25(a), Ex.P.26(a), Ex.P.27(a), Ex.P.28(a), Ex.P.29(a), Ex.P.31(a),(b).

5. During recording of the evidence prosecution get marked 8 articles sealed in the two covers, one box, five cloth knots i.e., blood stained soil, sample soil, finger nails of both hands along with clippings and nail cutter, a brown colour



half sleeve banian, a dark blue colour underwear, a black colour waist thread, a white colour thread with Rudraskshi at M.O.1 to 8.

6. After closure of the prosecution evidence on 16.04.2026 the statement of the accused as required under Section 313 of Cr.P.C. has been recorded. Accused denied the incriminating evidence appearing against him and did not choose evidence on his behalf.

7. I heard arguments submitted on behalf of both parties and perused entire records.

8. On the basis of the materials on record, following points would arise for my consideration;

1) Whether prosecution proves beyond reasonable doubt on 29.07.2025 at 4.30 p.m. at K.M.Doddi Village in the house when Shivamallappa refused to pay money accused being son of Shivamallappa abused Shivamallappa in filthy language, made assault with hands, made him to fell, resulting in bleeding from mouth and ear, forcibly pressed his neck, turned his head towards left and right,



thereby killed him (Shivamallappa), thereby committed thereby committed the offence punishable under Section 103 of B.N.S.-2023 (302 of IPC) ?

2) What order?

9. On the basis of the material available in the file, my finding to the above Points are as follows:-

Point No.1 : **In the Negative**

Point No.2 : As per final order
for the following:

10. **Point No.1 :-** In this case prosecution has alleged that on 29.07.2025 at 4.30 p.m. at K.M.Doddi Village in the house when Shivamallappa refused to pay money accused being son of Shivamallappa abused Shivamallappa in filthy language, made assault with hands, made him to fell, resulting in bleeding from mouth and ear, forcibly pressed his neck, turned his head towards left and right, thereby killed him (Shivamallappa).

11. Prosecution has contended that on 30.07.2025 at 10.00 a.m. PW-1/CW-2/Sunandamma W/o Shivamallappa



after receiving information about death of Shivamallappa from her son-in-law/Mahadevaswamy came to police station, presented the report marked at Ex.P.2 before PW-7/ASI, on the basis of the report marked at Ex.P.2, PW-7/ASI registered UDR No.18/2025, forwarded report marked at Ex.P.1 to the Tahsildar, Malavalli Taluk.

12. On 30.07.2025 since 1.00 p.m. to 3.00 p.m. at Government Hospital, Malavalli in the /presence of PW-5/CW-6/Nanjundaswamy, CW-7/Mohan S/o Mahadevaiah, CW-8/Sunilkumar S/o Mallikarjun, PW-7/ASI recorded the inquest mahazar marked at Ex.P.9, recorded the statement of PW-3/Vinutha S W/o Mahadevaswamy, PW-10/Subash Bharani S/o Govinda Raj, taken the photos, then, get autopsy of the body.

13. On the basis of the postmortem report and other medical reports, PW-10/CW-1/CPI prepared report marked at Ex.P.32, registered Cr.No.133/2025 against the accused for the offence punishable under Section 103 of B.N.S., 2023, forwarded FIR marked at Ex.P.31 to the jurisdictional Court and started investigation.



14. After completion of the investigation PW-10/CPI submitted charge sheet.

15. In the evidence PW-1/Sunandamma W/o Shivamallappa stated that CW-3/Mahadevaswamy, CW-5/Ranjan are her son-in-laws, CW-4/Vinutha and CW-9/Vanitha are her children/daughters. PW-1 stated that CW-6/Nanjundaswamy was the member of Bachanahalli Grama Panchayath. PW-1 stated that accused/Ajay is her son. PW-1 stated that as her husband, who was in the habit of consuming alcohol, made loan in the Bachanahalli Village, since prior to 7 months from July-2025 she get appointment in a garment, Bengaluru and resided in the house of her daughter/Vanitha R/o Bengaluru. PW-1 stated that she has resided in the house of her daughter/Vanitha at Bengaluru, her husband/Shivamallappa and son/Ajay resided at Bachanahalli Village. PW-1 stated that her daughter/Vinutha and her husband/Mahadevaswamy are residing at K.M.Doddi Village. PW-1 stated that prior to 7 months as on the date of her evidence, through mobile her



son-in-law/Mahadevaswamy informed the death of Shivamallappa in Bachanahalli Village, then, saw the body of her husband at Government Hospital, Malavalli, then filed a complaint marked at Ex.P.2 at Malavalli Rural Police Station.

16. In the evidence PW-2/CW-3/Mahadevaswamy @ Madesha/son-in-law of PW-1 stated that prior to 7 months as on the date of his evidence in the house situated at Bachanahalli Village his father-in-law/Shivamallappa expired. PW-2 stated that through mobile he informed the death of Shivamallappa at Bachanahalli Village to his mother-in-law/Sunandamma.

17. In the evidence PW-3/CW-4/Vinutha W/o Mahadevaswamy, D/o Shivamallappa stated that prior to 7 months as on July-2025 her mother get an employment in a garment, Bengaluru and started to reside with Vanitha and Ranjan, who are residing in Bengaluru. PW-3 stated that prior to 7 months as on the date of her evidence at Bachanahalli Village her father/Shivamallappa expired. PW-3



stated that she came to know that her father/Shivamallappa expired when fall under intoxication.

18. In the evidence PW-4/CW-7/Ranjan B S/o Basavaraju/son-in-law of PW-1/Sunandamma stated that since last 5 years along with wife residing at Bengaluru. PW-4 stated since last 7 months as on July-2025 his mother-in-law get an appointment in a garment situated at Bengaluru and started to reside in his house. PW-4 stated that prior to 7 months as on the date of his evidence at Bachanahalli Village his father-in-law/Shivamallappa expired. PW-4 stated that Mahadevaswamy through mobile informed the death of Shivamallappa to Sunandamma.

19. In the evidence PW-5/CW-6/Nanjundaswamy S/o Nanjaiah stated that prior to 1 ½ years as on the date of his evidence Shivamallappa expired. In the evidence PW-5 identified his signature on the inquest mahazar marked at Ex.P.9 and stated that in Malavalli Government Hospital when police have recorded the inquest mahazar on body of Shivamallappa made signature marked at Ex.P.9(a).



20. In the evidence PW-6/CW-14/Dr.Ashwini Narayana stated that on 31.07.2025 on the request of Malavalli Rural Police did autopsy of body of Shivamallappa, aged about 60 years, noticed following external and internal injuries:

- a) Contused abrasion 9 cm X 2 cm situated transversely 4 cm above the midvasicular line on the left lower neck.
- b) Small contused abrasion 1 cm X 1 cm seen over the right side of the neck, 3 cm below the right mid midvasicular area.
- c) Contusion 3 cm X 2 cm just below the left eye.
- d) Three finger nail scratch abrasions are below the other seen over the as pet part of the neck and over the sub-midvasicular area on the left side, situated one below and beneath the other at a distance of about 0.3 to 0.5 cm.
- e) Contusion 10 cm X 5 cm seen over the mid back area on deserting the wound, there is extravacation of blood.

21. PW-6 stated about issuance of provisional P.M. report. PW-6 stated that on 02.09.2025 along with P.M.report, Histopathology report, FSL report Halaguru Police



sent a letter to give final opinion about the reason for the death of Shivamallappa.

22. PW-6 stated that after comparing of P.M. report, Histopathology report, FSL report forwarded final report about reason for the death of Shivamallappa as due to combined effect of manual compression of neck and smothering .

23. In the cross-examination PW-6 submitted non-scribing of P.M.report and explained his dictation resident doctors/students wrote P.M. report. PW-6 denied the suggestion that Shivamallappa, who suffered from epilepsy, therefore fell on a hard surface area, suffered blood clot in the brain, which resulted in his death. PW-6 admitted that if an human being who is suffering from epilepsy may fell and loose his consciousness.

24. In the evidence PW-7/CW-30/Gangadhara J.A./ASI stated that on 30.07.2025 when he was discharged the duties of S.H.O., at 10.00 a.m. Sunandamma W/o



Shivamallappa came, handed over the report marked at Ex.P.2, then, on the basis of the report marked at Ex.P.2 registered UDR No.18/2025, forwarded the same to Tahsildar, Malavalli Taluk.

25. In the evidence PW-8/CW-32/Shivanandaswamy/ASI stated that on 30.07.2025 at Malavalli Government Hospital in the presence of Nanjundaswamy, Sunilkumar, Mohankumar inspected the body of Shivamallappa, aged about 60 years, recorded the inquest mahazar marked at Ex.P.9, Statement of Vanitha W/o Ranjan, Subash Bharani S/o Govinda. PW-8 stated that after recording inquest mahazar get autopsy of the body from the medical officers of MIMS.

26. In the evidence of PW-9/CW-42/Sridhara B.S. S/o Somaiah/CPI stated that during investigation Mahadevaswamy, Vinutha, Ranjan, Vanitha, Shivakumara, Kumara, Mahadevu, Kemparaju, Revanna gave statement as noted in the documents marked at Ex.P.5 to 7.



27. In the evidence PW-9 stated about collection of FSL report, Histopathology report, opinion of the doctor about reason for the death of Shivamallappa noted in the documents marked at Ex.P.12 to 14.

28. In the evidence PW-9 stated about collection of the RTC, sketch from the Revenue Department Officers and PWD Officers. PW-9 stated about collection of articles marked at M.O.1 to 8.

29. In the cross-examination PW-9 denied the suggestion that accused is not reason for the unnatural death of Shivamallappa. PW-9 denied the suggestion that in his presence Mahadevaswamy, Vinutha and Ranjan never gave statement as noted in the documents marked at Ex.P.5 to 7.

30. In the evidence PW-10/Mahesha B.G. S/o Ganesha H.R/Police Inspector, Malavalli Circle stated that on verification of the Postmortem report, inquest mahazar came to know that in view of the pressing of the neck



Shivamallappa expired, therefore, prepared report registered Cr.No.133/2025 for the offence punishable under Section 103 of B.N.S. against the accused, forwarded FIR marked at Ex.P.31 to the jurisdictional Court.

31. PW-10 stated that as per his direction at 7.00 p.m. of 31.07.2025 police staff have produced the accused. PW-10 stated that on 31.07.2025 recorded the statement of the accused. PW-10 stated that on 31.07.2025 by serving notice secured Nagaraju to work as panchas.

32. PW-10 stated that on 31.07.2025 at 8.15 p.m. in the presence of Nagaraju and Swamy inspected the place of incident shown by the accused, recorded the mahazar marked at Ex.P.16.

33. PW-10 stated that on 02.08.2025 recorded the statement of Sunandamma, Umesha, Suresha, Shivakumara, Banappa, Koushik, Manikanta and Rajesha. PW-10 stated that in his presence Sunandamma gave statement as noted in the document marked at Ex.P.3.



34. In the cross-examination PW-10 denied the suggestion that accused is not the reason of unnatural death of Shivamallappa. PW-10 denied the suggestion that Sunandamma never gave statement as noted in the document marked at Ex.P.3. PW-10 denied the suggestion about non-recording of the mahazar marked at Ex.P.16 on 31.07.2025 at 8.15 p.m. in the place shown by the accused.

35. In the report marked at Ex.P.2 it is noted that on 30.07.2025 at 10.00 a.m. PW-1/Sunandamma filed the same before PW-7/ASI alleging that her husband/Shivamallappa, who was in the habit of consuming alcohol, several times fell due to epilepsy, in the same method previous day i.e., on 29.07.2025 under intoxication due to epilepsy fell and suffered unnatural death.

36. Report marked at Ex.P.1 shows that on the basis of the complaint marked at Ex.P.2 PW-7/ASI registered UDR No.18/2025, forwarded UDR file to Tahsildar, Malavalli Taluk.



37. In the inquest mahazar marked at Ex.P.9 it is noted that on 30.07.2025 at 1.00 p.m. at mortuary, Government Hospital, Malavalli in the presence of CW-5/Ranjan S/o Basavaraju, CW-7/Mohan S/o Mahadevaiah, CW-8/Sunilkumar S/o Mallikarjun, PW-8/ASI recorded the inquest mahazar taken the photos of body, recorded the statement of Vanitha W/o Ranjan, Subash Bharani S/o Govindaraj.

38. In the mahazar marked at Ex.P.16 it is noted that on 31.07.2025 at 8.15 p.m. in the presence of CW-15/Nagaraju S/o Late Mallaiah, CW-16 Swamy M. S/o Mallikarjun inspected the place shown by the accused and recorded the mahazar.

39. In the mahazar marked at Ex.P.18 it is noted that on 30.07.2025 at 3.30 p.m. in the presence of CW-11/Rajesh S/o Nanjundaiah and CW-12/Mallikarjuna S/o Kempaiah CW-36/Shravanadasa Reddi/PSI inspected the place shown by CW-3/PW-2/Mahadevaswamy and recorded the mahazar.



40. In the P.M. report marked at Ex.P.10 reason for the death is noted as due to asphyxia as a result of regarding compression of neck and final opinion of the cause of death (after verification of the RFSL report, HPE, CT-virtual autopsy) is noted as death is due to asphyxia as a result of combined effects of Manual compression of neck and smothering.

41. In this case regarding reason for the death of Shivamallappa there are no eyewitness.

42. In this case as referred above in the evidence PW-1 to 4/Sunandamma W/o Shivamallappa, Mahadevaswamy S/o Mahadeva/son-in-law of Sunandamma, Vanitha/daughter of Sunandamma, Ranjan B./son-in-law of Sunandamma stated nothing regarding relationship between death of Shivamallappa and accused/Ajay.

43. In this case evidence placed by the prosecution regarding reason for the death of Shivamallappa has not been



supported by wife, daughters and son-in-laws of Shivamallappa, therefore, a reasonable doubt arose in the mind of the Court about genuineness and truthfulness of the evidence placed by the prosecution about the reason for the death of Shivamallappa and relationship between accused and reason for the death of Shivamallappa.

44. In view of the non-corroboration of the oral evidence of PW-1 to 4/wife, daughters, son-in-laws about reason for the death of Shivamallappa with the reasons noted in the P.M. report, medical records, I have inferred that accused is entitle for benefit of doubt.

45. Hence, by extending benefit of doubt in favour of the accused I came to the conclusion that prosecution has failed to prove beyond reasonable doubt that on 29.07.2025 at 4.30 p.m. at K.M.Doddi Village in the house when Shivamallappa refused to pay money accused being son of Shivamallappa abused Shivamallappa in filthy language, made assault with hands, made him to fell, resulting in bleeding from mouth and ear, forcibly pressed his neck,



turned his head towards left and right, thereby killed him (Shivamallappa), thereby committed thereby committed the offence punishable under Section 103 of B.N.S.-2023 (302 of IPC). Hence, I answer **point No.1 in the Negative** and pass the following:

ORDER

Acting under Section 255 of B.N.S.S., 2023 (235(1) of Cr.P.C.,) I acquit accused/Ajay S. from the charges of the offence punishable under Section 103 of B.N.S., 2023 (Section 302 of IPC).

It is directed the accused to execute personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- undertaking to appear before the appellate Authority in case receipt of the summons/notice within 6 months from today.

It is directed to Office to destroy blood stained soil, sample soil, finger nails of both hands along with clippings and nail cutter, a brown colour half sleeve banian, a dark blue colour underwear, a black colour waist thread, a white colour thread with Rudraskshi marked at M.O.1 to 8 after completion of the appeal period.



It is directed to the office after execution of the personal bond by the accused to intimate the concerned jailer to release the accused if his further detention is not required for any other purpose.
