Petitioner and his counsel are present. Learned counsel for the respondent No.2 is also present.

The petitioner and the Respondent No.2 have filed joint memo by stating that the claim petition filed by the petitioner has been settled between them amicably for a sum of Rs.2,85,000/- (Rupees Two lakh eighty five thousand only).

Contents of the Joint memo read over to the Petitioner in Kannada language known to him. The Petitioner admit the contents of joint memo.

Perused the terms of the settlement. The settlement between the parties to the proceeding is just and reasonable. The same appears to be lawful.
